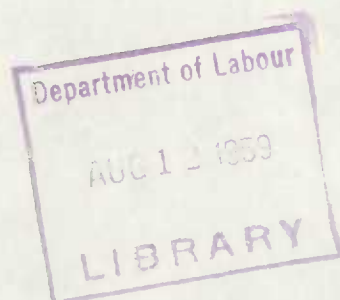

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

INTRODUCTION

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given in the report for April, 1958. Wherever possible the numbers of persons employed, as published in this report, are based on a count of the number on strength on the final day of the month. In some cases published reports of departments and corporations give a count of the number of persons paid during the final pay period or on strength on the final pay day in the month and hence they may not agree with data shown in this publication.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND
OTHER QUASI-INDEPENDENT GOVERNMENT BODIES

The strike of 1,150 employees of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation ended on March 9th. On March 19th 1,860 workers of the Polymer Corporation struck over wages and working conditions. The loss of earnings of these employees was between \$300,000 and \$350,000 during March. The strike continued during April. Transportation employees of the Canadian National Railways received almost \$900,000 back pay during March 1959. This amount has been included below.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

Due to the seasonal increase of staff in the Taxation Branch of National Revenue the function General Government - Executive and Administrative showed a rise of 741 salaried employees. Prevailing Rate and Ships employees recorded virtually no change. Casuals were 470 lower in Transportation and Communications - Waterways and 343 lower in Social Welfare - National Employment Services. Both reductions were largely seasonal in nature.

Regular employment at 182,944 was 1.3 p.c. above that for March, 1958 and 14.1 p.c. higher than in March, 1954. Regular earnings of \$55,665,712 were 4.3 p.c. above those for March 1958 and 39.8 p.c. over March five years previously. In the five year period salaried employment rose 14.0 p.c. and the regular earnings of salaried employees by 39.7 p.c.
