## FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

September, 1959

INTRODUCTION

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given in the report for April 1959. Total staff strength declined by 5,492 in September 1959 as compared with August but was 3,831 higher than in September 1958. Earnings of staff decreased by \$1,417,000 from August but were up \$5,277,000 from September 1958.

The nine month total of earnings of all persons employed by the Federal Government was just under one billion dollars (\$998,295,000) a rise of 5.0 p.c. compared with \$951 millions for the equivalent period of 1958. Staff of Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies earned \$448 millions in the first nine months of 1959 compared with \$421 millions to the same date in 1958, a rise of 6.4 p.c. Employees of Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations earned \$550 millions from January 1 to September 30, 1959 up \$20 millions or 3.8 p.c. from the same nine months in 1958.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

The number of employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations in September, 1959 was 1,185 lower than August, 1959. The decline was due mainly to seasonal decreases by the Canadian National Railways, Atomic Energy of Canada Ltd. and the Eldorado Mining and Refining Ltd. Earnings of these employees decreased by \$589,000 in September, 1959 as compared with August, 1959.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

Salaried employees declined in the functions "Defence Services", "General Government - Executive and Administrative" and "Natural Resources and Primary Industries - (a) Fish and Game, (b) Lands: Settlement and Agriculture, (c) Minerals and Mines and (d) Other" due mainly to the termination of summer assignments to Student Assistants in the departments of National Defence, National Revenue, Agriculture and Mines and Technical Surveys. Seasonal decreases in prevailing rate employees were recorded in the functions "Defence Services", "Recreational and Cultural Services - Parks etc." and "Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Lands: Settlement and Agriculture". There were fewer casual employees in the functions "Defence Services", "General Government - Executive and Administrative", "Social Welfare - National Employment Services", "Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Other" and "Other-Other" but more in the functions "Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Lands: Settlement and Agriculture" and "Other - Post Office".
