FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

NOVEMBER, 1961

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1961.

INTRODUCTION

This report includes some estimated figures for the Department of National Defence for which November 1961 data are only partially available. For detail, see tables in Part B.

The Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, had a staff strength of 342,322 at the end of November 1961. There were, thus, 2,143 fewer employees than October 1961 with all of the five main groups except departmental corporations recording a decrease. The November 1961 total was up 0.8 p.c. or 2,757 from the 339,565 employed in the same month a year ago.

Total staff earning for November 1961 amounted to \$125,025,000, down by 1.7 p.c. or \$2,112,000 from October 1961, but up by 4.3 p.c. or \$5,199,000 from November 1960.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

The Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies employees numbered 138,609 at the end of November 1961. This represents a decline of 1.3 p.c. or 1,892 from the previous month and a decline of 0.7 p.c. or 982 from November 1960.

The decline was due mostly to a staff reduction by the Canadian National Railways which reported some 1,500 fewer employees, and a reduction of over \$2,000,000 in earnings. The railway reduced staff in most provinces, especially in Ontario. Earnings of employees decreased by \$1,983,000 from the previous month but increased by \$2,435,000 from November 1960.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

In order to avoid further delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews, and casual staff in the entire Department of National Defence. The Pacific Region Air Services is included for the first time with some 120 prevailing rate and casual employees earning over \$40,000 for the month; salaried employees were already included.

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations totalled 203,713 at the end of November 1961. This represents a slight decline of 251 from October 1961 but was up by 1.9 p.c. or 3,739 from November 1960. Total employee earnings for the month under review amounted to \$70,624,000, down \$129,000 from October 1961, but 4.1 p.c. or \$2,764,000 higher than November 1960.

The slight decline in staff from October 1961 was reflected in a drop of 427 salaried employees, and of 17 ships' officers and crews, partially offset by increases of 4 in prevailing rate and, 189 in casual employees. Employment declined in Newfoundland, the Prairie provinces and the Yukon and Northwest Territories, but increased in the Maritime and Central provinces, British Columbia and those employed outside Canada.

Analysis of the November 1961 data with the previous month by function indicates a substantial decline in the function "General Government - Research, Planning and Statistics" resulting from decreasing Census staff of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics; a decrease in the function "Transportation and Communications - Waterways", seasonal in nature; a substantial increase in the function "Social Welfare - National Employment Services"; caused by the seasonal rise in unemployment which requires a larger staff to handle claims and job applications; and a seasonal decrease in the group of functions "Natural Resources and Primary Industries".
