FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

DECEMBER, 1961

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1961.

INTRODUCTION

This report includes some estimated figures for the Department of National Defence for which November and December, 1961 data are incomplete. For details, see tables in Part B.

Employees of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, numbered 337,456 at the end of December, 1961. This represents a decline from November of 4,866 employees, resulting mainly from a reduction of 3,839 in proprietary corporations, and of 1,027 in departmental branches, services and corporations. The December, 1961 total was up 978 from the 336,478 employed in the same month a year ago.

Total staff earnings for the month under review amounted to \$124,291,000; down by \$734,000 from November, 1961, but up by \$3,409,000 from December, 1960.

Earnings for the period January 1 to December 31, 1961 amounted to \$1,504,596,000, an increase of \$88,023,000 or 6.2% over the corresponding 1960 period.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

These government organizations employed 3,839 fewer staff than in November, 1961, and 1,214 less than in December, 1960. This represented reductions of 2.8 p.c. from November, 1961 and 0.9 p.c. from December, 1960.

The decline in employment was mainly the result of decreases reported by the Canadian National Railways.

Total staff earnings for the month under review amounted to \$53,428,000, down by \$973,000 (1.8%) from November, but up by \$1,846,000 (3.6%) over December, 1960.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

In order to avoid further delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews, and casual staff in the entire Department of National Defence.

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations totalled 202,686 in December, 1961. This represents a decline of 1,027, or 0.5% from November, but an increase of 2,192 or 1.1% over December of the preceding year. Total employee earnings for December, 1961 amounted to \$70,864,000, an increase of \$240,000 or 0.3% over the previous month and was up \$1,565,000 or 2.3% over December, 1960.

The December reduction in staff from November, 1961 can be mostly attributed to a decrease in seasonal activities, with a corresponding decrease in casual, ships' officers and crews and prevailing rate employees. Analysis of the data indicates a decrease in the functions "General Government - Research, Planning and Statistics", resulting from a gradual release of 1961 Census staff by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics; a seasonal decline of prevailing rate, ships employees and casual staff in the group of functions "National Resources and Primary Industries", and "Transportation", notably waterways.

The functions "Defence Services" and "Social Welfare - National Employment Services", show a fairly substantial increase in casual employment.
