

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

MAY, 1961

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1961.

INTRODUCTION

This report includes some estimated figures for the Department of National Defence for which May data are only partially available. For detail, see tables in Part B.

Preliminary figures indicate that the total staff strength of the Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, increased by 6,609 to 341,149 in May 1961 over the previous month and by 205 over May 1960. Earnings for May 1961 amounted to \$125,490,000, up by \$6,339,000 over April 1961, and by \$8,429,000 over May 1960.

The staff strength was higher in May over April 1961 in four of the five groups of Federal organizations with Departmental Corporations being the only group to show lower employment. The most significant increases occurred in Proprietary Corporations, up by 3,120 and in Departmental Branches and Services, up by 3,466 employees.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

The number of employees in Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies for May 1961 increased by 3,410 over April 1961, and was lower by 5,455 compared with May 1960. Earnings for April 1961 increased by \$5,349,000 over the previous month, and was higher by \$1,694,000 over May 1960.

The largest employer, the Canadian National Railways, recorded a substantial increase in employment over the previous month with all provinces but Nova Scotia sharing in this increase. The Northern Transportation Company Limited, and the National Harbours Board recorded a relatively substantial increase over the previous month.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

In order to avoid delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews and casual staff in the entire department of National Defence.

Preliminary figures for May 1961 indicate a total staff strength of 204,048, up by 3,199 employees over the previous month. Employment was higher for all of the four types of employees, the most significant of which were, salaried, up by 1,522 employees, and prevailing rate, up by 988 employees. This trend is similar to the corresponding months of 1960 where employment rose by 3,382 to a total of 198,388 in May 1960. Total earnings rose by \$990,000 to \$70,038,000 in May 1961 with all of the four types of employment indicating higher earnings.

The most important variations in staff strength over the previous month are: a) decrease of salaried employees, increase of prevailing rate and casual employees in the function "Defence Services", b) decrease of casual employees in function "Social Welfare - National Employment Services", c) increase of prevailing rate employees in function "Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Lands: Settlement and "Agriculture".
