#### FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

#### JANUARY, 1962

#### NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1961.

#### INTRODUCTION

This report includes some estimated figures for the Department of National Defence for which January 1962 data are only partially available. For detail, see tables in Part B.

The Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, employed 337,703 persons at the end of January 1962. Staff strength was almost unchanged being up only 247 from the total reported for December 1961, and only 0.3 p.c. or 970 from January 1961. The staff of the departmental branches and services increased by 2,647 from December 1961, but was largely offset by a drop of 2,031 employees of proprietary corporations.

Total Government payrolls amounted to \$125,302,000 for January 1962, up 0.8 p.c. or \$1,011,000 from December 1961 and 3.9 p.c. or \$4,701,000 from January 1961.

#### PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

The Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies had a total staff strength of 132,351 at the end of January 1962. This total indicates decreases of 1.8 p.c. or 2,419 from the preceding month and 1.6 p.c. or 2,104 from January 1961. The decline from December 1961 was due mostly to the Canadian National Railways staff reduction of nearly 2,000 employees. The National Harbours Board and Trans-Canada Air Lines also reported staff reductions.

Total payrolls for the month under review amounted to \$53,587,000, up by 0.3 p.c. or \$159,000 from December 1961 and up by 4.5 p.c. or \$2,322,000 from January 1961. The Canadian National Railways reported a payroll increase to employees in the United States amounting to \$150,000 over December.

#### PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

In order to avoid further delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships officers and crews, and casual staff in the entire Department of National Defence.

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations numbered 205,352 at the end of January 1962. This represents increases of 1.3 p.c. or 2,666 from the preceding month and of 1.5 p.c. or 3,074 from January 1961. Total employee earnings for January 1962 amounted to \$71,715,000, up 1.2 p.c. or \$851,000 from December 1961 and 3.4 p.c. or \$2,379,000 from January 1961.

The types of employees accounting for most of the staff increase from December 1961 were, salaried, up by 1,137 and, casuals, up by 1,480. The bulk of staff increase took place in Ontario, where numbers increased 1,334 from December 1961.

Analysis of the January 1962 data with the preceding month by function indicates: a substantial increase (mostly of casual employees) in the function "Defence Services"; a similar gain (for salaried staff) in the function "General Government-Legislative" due to the convening of Parliament during the month; an increase in the function "Recreational and Cultural Services - Parks, Beaches and other Recreational Areas", (mostly prevailing rate and casual employees); a decrease in the group of functions "Natural Resources and Primary Industries", seasonal in nature; and an increase in the function "Other-Post Office", (mostly casual employees).
