

#### FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

#### FEBRUARY, 1962

#### NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1961.

#### INTRODUCTION

This report includes some estimated figures for the Department of National Defence for which February 1962 data are only partially available. For additional detail, see tables in Part B.

The Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, had 337,949 persons on payroll at the end of February 1962. This represents a slight increase of 246 from January 1962, and an increase of 1,959 or 0.6 p.c. from February 1961. The proprietary corporations staff declined by some 111 from January 1962 and departmental corporations decreased by 157, but these were offset by an increase of 539 in departmental branches and services.

Total Government payrolls amounted to \$123,769,000 for February 1962, down by 1.2 p.c. or \$1,533,000 from January 1962 and up by 4.3 p.c. or \$5,080,000 from February 1961. The reduced payroll in February, in contrast with January 1962, was the result of fewer man-hours worked by hourly-rated employees. This reduction in man-hours was due, in turn, to fewer working days in February, the shortest month in the year.

#### PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

The Agency and Proprietary Corporations and Other Agencies had a total of 132,215 employees at the end of February 1962. This indicates a slight decrease of 136 from January 1962 and a decrease of 605 from February 1961.

Total payroll for February 1962 amounted to \$51,665,000, down 3.6 p.c. or \$1,922,000 from January 1962 but up by 5.5. p.c. or \$2,709,000 from February 1961. The decrease from January 1962 is accounted for mainly by the Canadian National Railways with a decline of almost \$2,000,000.

#### PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

In order to avoid further delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews, and casual staff of the entire Department of National Defence.

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations totalled 205,734 at the end of February 1962. This indicates increases of 0.2 p.c. or 382 from January 1962 and of 1.3 p.c. or 2,564 from February 1961. Total earnings of these employees amounted to \$72,103,000 for February 1962, up by 0.5 p.c. or \$388,000 from January 1962, and up by 3.4 p.c. or \$2,370,000 from February 1961.

Comparison of the February 1962 data with those for the preceding month, by function, indicates a substantial increase of casual employees in the function "Defence Services" with all Services of National Defence sharing in the increase; decreases in prevailing rate and casual employees in the function "Recreational and Cultural Services ~ Parks, Beaches and other Recreational Areas"; and an increase in casual employees in the function "National Resources and Primary Industries - Other"; other variations were of less significance.

In the provincial distribution of these employees, the most significant variations occurred in Ontario, up by 493; in Nova Scotia, down by 150; in British Columbia, down by 119 and in the Yukon and Northwest Territories, up by 107.
