

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

MARCH, 1962

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1961.

INTRODUCTION

This report includes some estimated figures for the Department of National Defence for which March 1962 data are only partially available. For additional detail, see tables in Part B.

The Government of Canada, including its corporations and agencies, had 337,083 persons on payroll at the end of March 1962. This represents a decrease of 0.3 p.c. or 866 from February 1962 and a decrease of 0.1 p.c. or 333 from March 1961. The proprietary corporations staff increased by some 475 from February 1962, whereas departmental branches and services decreased by 808.

Total Government payrolls amounted to \$127,300,000 for March 1962, up by 2.9 p.c. or \$3,531,000 from February 1962 and up by 4.2 p.c. or \$5,095,000 from March 1961. The increased payroll in March 1962, compared with the previous month, is due to the inclusion of retroactive payments covering a substantial group of employees, and to increased man-hours worked by hourly-rated employees due to more working days in the month.

The total earnings of Federal Government employees for the fiscal year ended March 1962 was up by 5.6 p.c. or \$80,101,000 from the fiscal year ended March 1961.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

The Agency and Proprietary Corporations and other Agencies had a total of 132,622 employees at the end of March 1962. This indicates an increase of 0.3 p.c. or 407 from February 1962 and a decrease of 1.5 p.c. or 1,987 from March 1961. The increase from February 1962 was mostly due to the Canadian National Railways.

Total payroll for March 1962 amounted to \$53,830,000 up 4.2 p.c. or \$2,165,000 from February 1962 and up 3.3 p.c. or \$1,716,000 from March 1961. The increase is accounted for mainly by the Canadian National Railways with an increase of \$1,800,000.

Total payroll for the fiscal year ended March 1962 amounted to \$666,563,000, up by 4.8 p.c. or \$30,281,000 from \$636,282,000 for the fiscal year ending March 1961.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

In order to avoid further delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews, and casual staff of the entire Department of National Defence.

Salary revisions were announced for a group of salaried employees effective July 1, 1961. It is estimated that some 5,600 employees had increases close to \$2,000,000 for the period July 1961 to February 1962. This amount is included in Table 3B under "Retroactive payments reported". Regular earnings for March 1962 include the revised salaries for that month.

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations totalled 204,461 at the end of March 1962. This represents a decrease of 0.6 p.c. or 1,273 from February 1962 but an increase of 0.8 p.c. or 1,654 from March 1961. Total earnings of these employees amounted to \$73,470,000 for March 1962, up by 1.9 p.c. or \$1,367,000 from February 1962 and up by 4.8 p.c. or \$3,379,000 from March 1961.

Analysis of the March 1962 data with those of February 1962 by function, indicates a decrease of close to 1,000 casual employees in the function "Defence Services", particularly Royal Canadian Air Force and Canadian Army of National Defence; a decrease of close to 500 casual employees in the function "Social Welfare - National Employment Services"; a decrease of casual employees in the function "Transportation and Communications - Waterways"; and an increase of salaried employees in the function "General Government - Executive and Administrative", mainly Taxation Division of National Revenue; other variations were of less significance.

Total employee earnings for the fiscal year ended March 1962 amounted to \$853,880,000, up 6.2 p.c. or \$49,820,000 from \$804,060,000 for the fiscal year ended March 1961. Earnings of salaried employees increased by \$47,848,000 to \$712,990,000.
