FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series was given, together with other background detail, in the report for April, 1962.

INTRODUCTION

This report includes some estimated figures for the Department of National Defence for which May 1962 data are only partially available. For additional detail, see tables in Part B.

The Government of Canada including its corporations and agencies, had 345,260 persons on payroll at the end of May 1962. This represents an increase of 2.5 p.c. or 8,269 from April 1962 and an increase of 1.4 p.c. or 4,614 from May 1961.

The staff of Agency Corporations increased by 416 from April 1962; those of Proprietary Corporations increased by 3,907 mainly due to the Canadian National Railways; Other Agencies increased by 2; Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations increased by 4,083 due mainly to seasonal increases in several departments; while Departmental Corporations declined by 139 due principally to the Unemployment Insurance Commission.

Total Federal Government payrolls amounted to \$130,004,000 for May 1962, up by 3.5 p.c. or \$4,392,000 from April 1962 and up by 3.3 p.c. or \$4,141,000 from May 1961.

PART A - AGENCY AND PROPRIETARY CORPORATIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES

Agency and Proprietary Corporations and other Agencies aggregated 137,504 employees in May 1962, up by 3.2 p.c. or 4,325 from April 1962 and up by 0.3 p.c. or 403 from May 1961. The Canadian National Railways reported an increase of some 3,500 employees in May 1962 over the previous month resulting mainly from substantial hirings following the trucking strike.

Earnings of these employees amounted to \$56,980,000 in May 1962, up by 6.3 p.c. or \$3,365,000 from April 1962, and up by 2.8 p.c. or \$1,528,000 from May 1961. The bulk of the increase from April 1962 is accounted for by the Canadian National Railways, up by over \$3,000,000, resulting from the above-noted hirings, overtime, wage increases and retroactive payments, as well as seasonal increases.

PART B - DEPARTMENTAL BRANCHES, SERVICES AND CORPORATIONS

In order to avoid further delay in the release of this report, estimated figures have been included for salaried staff of Defence Research and Development, and, prevailing rate, ships' officers and crews, and casual staff of the entire Department of National Defence.

Employees in Departmental Branches, Services and Corporations numbered 207,756 at the end of May 1962, representing an increase of 1.9 p.c. or 3,944 over April 1962, and an increase of 2.1 p.c. or 4,201 over May 1961. Total earnings of these employees amounted to \$73,024,000 in May 1962 up by 1.4 p.c. or \$1,028,000 from April 1962 and up by 3.7 p.c. or \$2,614,000 from May of last year.

Analysis by functions, of the May 1962 staff strength, with those of April 1962 indicates the following main features: (1) increases in the function "Defence Services" of salaried employees, mostly summer employment in Defence Research and Development; of prevailing rate employees due to summer training of militia, reserve and cadets, in Canadian Army and Royal Canadian Air Force; of casual employees, particularly of day labour and construction maintenance, in Canadian Army and Royal Canadian Air Force; (2) an increase of casual employees in the function "Transportation and Communications - Airways" due mainly to seasonal increase in Transport - Air Services; (3) a decline of casual employees in function "Social Welfare - National Employment and Unemployment Insurance Services"; (4) an increase of prevailing rate employees in the function "Recreational and Cultural Services - Parks, Beaches and Other Recreational Areas" due to seasonal increase in National Parks Branch of Northern Affairs and National Resources; (5) an increase in salaried employees in the function "Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Fish and Game" due to seasonal increase in the Department of Fisheries; (6) an increase of prevailing rate employees in the function "Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Lands: Settlement and Agriculture", mainly due to seasonal increase in Research Branch of Agriculture Department.
