

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## INTRODUCTION

This publication presents information with respect to employment and payrolls of the federal government and federal government enterprises. It provides information for the quarter ending September 30, 1971 and also for the three months included therein.

Statistics Canada being precluded from publishing data which might permit identification of individuals, it has been necessary to combine data in respect of the executive category with those in respect of the scientific and professional category.

Employment in the federal government, including enterprises but excluding members of the Canadian Forces, was 402.1 thousand as of September 30, 1971. This represented an increase of 0.6 thousand or 0.1 per cent over the total as of June 30, 1971 and 23.5 thousand or 6.2 per cent over the total as of September 30, 1970.

Total payroll for the quarter, as reported in this publication, was \$883.1 million and represented an increase of \$141.8 million over the total for the previous three month period. This increase was due to there being three pay periods in July and to retroactive pay increases within the proprietary corporations group.

For an explanation of the terms used in this publication refer to the April-June 1971 report.

PART A

Agency Corporations, Proprietary Corporations and  
Other Agencies and Corporations

The total number of employees within this category was 140.4 thousand as of September 30, 1971, an increase of 0.3 thousand over the total as of June 30, 1971 and a decrease of 1.1 thousand from the total as of September 30, 1970.

Gross payroll for the quarter was \$348.9 million, an increase of \$56.7 million over the previous quarter and \$35.0 million over the comparable period of 1970.

PART B

Departments and Departmental Corporations

The total number of employees in this category was 261.7 thousand at the end of September 1971 and represented an increase of 0.9 thousand over the total at the end of June 1971 and 24.5 thousand over the total at the end of September 1970.

Total payroll for the quarter was \$534.2 million, an increase of \$85.1 million over the total for the previous quarter and \$70.3 million over the comparable period of 1970.

Consequently, movements of personnel between "departments" are treated in the same way as movements into and out of the government service. The aggregate hirings and separations are summed up in "Total - all departments". It should be noted, therefore, that hiring and separation data for the entire Government of Canada as an employer cannot be secured from this table.

It should also be noted that the totals shown in this table differ from hiring and separation data published by the Public Service Commission of Canada. The latter organization treats all staff employed under the authority of the Public Service Employment Act as a complete unit and consequently is concerned only with movements into and out of "Act" employment. The Commission therefore is not concerned with inter-departmental movements of employees, but, with movements of staff to and from "Act" employment even when such movements occur within a department.



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
