

## INTRODUCTION

This publication presents information with respect to employment in and payrolls of the federal government and federal government enterprises, for the quarter ending March 31, 1972 and each of the months included therein.

Statistics Canada being precluded from publishing data which might permit the identification of individuals, it has been necessary to combine data in respect of the executive category with those in respect of the scientific and professional category.

Employment in the federal government, including enterprises but excluding members of the Canadian Forces, totalled 405.0 thousand as at March 31, 1972. This represented an increase of 3.5 thousand over the number employed as of December 31, 1971, and an increase of 20.0 thousand over the number employed as of March 31, 1971. The December to March increase was due in part to the employment, by the Department of National Revenue, of some 2.5 thousand casual employees to assist in the processing of the 1971 income tax returns. The balance of the increase reflects the rises in employment in all departments offset to some extent by a decrease of 3.2 thousand in employment in federal government enterprises.

Payrolls for the three month period January-March, 1972, amounted to \$812.3 million, a decrease of \$39.1 million from the payrolls for the previous three month period. This decrease was primarily due to an extra pay period occurring in December. Total payroll excludes, for departments and departmental corporations, overtime payments and retroactive salary increase payments for which analyses by occupational categories were not available.

For an explanation of the terms used in this publication refer to the April-June 1971 report.

PART A

Agency Corporations, Proprietary Corporations and  
Other Agencies and Corporations

The total number of employees within this category was 131.4 thousand as of March 31, 1972, a decrease of 3.2 thousand from the total as of December 31, 1971 and, 3.1 thousand from the total as at March 31, 1971.

Gross payroll for the quarter was \$308.2 million, an increase of \$4.6 million over the previous quarter and an increase of \$22.9 million over January-March 1971.

PART B

Departments and Departmental Corporations

The total number of employees in this category was 273.5 thousand at the end of March 1972, an increase of 6.7 thousand over the total at the end of December 1971. The Department of National Revenue recorded the greatest increase due to the hiring of 2.5 thousand casual employees to help process the 1971 income tax returns.

Total payroll for the quarter amounted to \$504.0 million, a decrease of \$43.7 million from the total for the previous quarter. As noted in the introduction this was primarily the result of the extra pay period in the previous quarter.

Compared to the quarter ended March 31, 1971, payrolls increased by \$73.7 million and the number of employees increased by 22.9 thousand.



and the other two were the same. The first was a  
large, dark, irregular mass, which had been  
broken off from a larger one. It was  
about 10 cm. long and 5 cm. wide. The second  
was a smaller, more compact mass, about 5 cm.  
long and 3 cm. wide. Both were made of  
a dark, reddish-brown material, possibly  
iron oxide or hematite. They were  
covered in small, sharp, pointed  
projections, which looked like  
tiny spikes or thorns. The  
surfaces of the stones were  
smooth, but there were some  
small, irregular depressions and  
grooves on them. The  
stones were found in a  
cave, which was located in  
a rocky area, possibly a  
mountainous region. The  
cave was quite large and  
deep, with many rooms and  
passages. The stones were  
found in one of the larger  
rooms, near the entrance. They  
were placed on a low, flat  
surface, possibly a rock or  
a piece of debris. There  
were no other objects  
nearby, except for some  
small, broken pieces of  
ceramic pottery and  
some animal bones.
