




Wages and Salaries in the Goods-producing and the Service-producing Industries — Seasonally Adjusted

ESTIMATES OF LABOUR INCOMEESTIMATIONS DU REVENU DU TRAVAILApril-June - 1976 - Avril-juin

During the second quarter of 1976 labour income, adjusted for seasonal variation, increased by 4.7 per cent; this compares to a gain of 4.4 per cent during the previous quarter.

The main increase in the second quarter occurred during May and was primarily due to two factors: a 17 per cent advance payment of retroactive pay to the Quebec public sector employees and an increase in employer paid premiums to the Ontario Health Insurance Plan. If the effects of irregularities such as the above, strikes and other special lump sum payments are removed the seasonally adjusted second quarter estimates show an increase of 2.8 per cent; in comparison, the first quarter shows a gain of 4.1 per cent. Except for the federal and provincial governments all industry divisions contributed to a decline in the rate of growth.

Wages and salaries in the goods-producing industries, adjusted for seasonal variation, advanced by 2.3 per cent during the second quarter, this is down from 4.9 per cent recorded during the previous period. Removing strike and special lump sum payments effects, the respective percentages are 1.6 and 3.9.

In the service-producing industries, seasonally adjusted wages and salaries increased by 5.6 per cent during the most recent period; by comparison, the advance was 3.7 per cent for the first quarter. Removing strikes and special payments, the gain was 2.8 per cent and 3.7 per cent for the respective quarters. The acceleration in the rate of growth was mainly the result of retroactive payments received by the Quebec public sector employees.

Au cours du deuxième trimestre de 1976, le revenu désaisonnalisé du travail a augmenté de 4.7 %, alors qu'il avait progressé de 4.4 % au cours du trimestre précédent.

Au deuxième trimestre, l'augmentation la plus importante s'est produite en mai et était surtout attribuable à deux facteurs: des paiements anticipés de 17 % au titre d'un rappel de salaire versés aux employés du secteur public du Québec et une augmentation des primes payées par l'employeur au Régime d'assurance-maladie de l'Ontario. Si l'on fait abstraction des répercussions entraînées par ces facteurs ainsi que par les grèves et par le versement d'autres montants forfaitaires spéciaux, les estimations désaisonnalisées du deuxième trimestre feront ressortir une augmentation de 2.8 %, en comparaison d'une augmentation de 4.1 % enregistrée au premier trimestre. À l'exception des administrations fédérale et provinciales, toutes les divisions de l'activité économique ont contribué à une baisse du taux d'accroissement.

Au cours du deuxième trimestre, les salaires et les traitements désaisonnalisés ont progressé de 2.3 % dans les industries de biens, alors que l'augmentation était de 4.9 % au cours de la période précédente. Si l'on ne tient pas compte des grèves et des montants forfaitaires spéciaux, ces proportions sont respectivement de 1.6 % et de 3.9 %.

Au cours de la période la plus récente, les salaires et les traitements désaisonnalisés ont augmenté de 5.6 % dans les industries de services, comparativement à une augmentation de 3.7 % au cours du premier trimestre. Si l'on fait abstraction des grèves et des montants forfaitaires spéciaux, les augmentations pour ces trimestres ont été respectivement de 2.8 % et de 3.7 %. L'augmentation du taux d'accroissement provient en grande partie des rappels touchés par les employés du secteur public du Québec.



Labour income is defined as the compensation paid to employees for services rendered comprising wages and salaries and supplementary labour income. It includes all such payments made to residents of Canada (Canadians employed by the federal government abroad are considered to be residents of Canada) except those made to the Canadian Armed Forces. Remuneration to the latter fits the definition of labour income but are excluded here as they are treated as a separate item in the National Income Accounts.

Wages and salaries include directors' fees, bonuses, commissions and taxable allowances and benefits. A gross concept has been adopted, and wages and salaries are measured before deductions for employees' contributions to income tax, unemployment insurance, pension funds, etc. Supplementary labour income, which is defined as payments made by employers for future benefit of employees, is composed of employers' contributions to employee welfare and pension funds including the Canada and Quebec pension plans, to the workmen's compensation funds, and to unemployment insurance.

The general method used in the preparation of the labour income estimates is to establish annual data or benchmarks by province for selected industry groups and to allocate these data by month.

The annual estimates are based in most cases on data derived from monthly and annual full-coverage and sample surveys conducted by Statistics Canada, the decennial and quinquennial censuses of Canada and the public accounts of the federal and provincial governments. These estimates are adjusted in light of the aggregations of employers' reports to the Department of National Revenue which yield a close approximation to total wages and salaries as defined above.

The main indicators used to interpolate and extrapolate census data, project annual data and allocate national data to provinces are one or more of the following:

- (a) A payroll index for large firms.(1)
- (b) Number of employees as tabulated for the preparation of Estimates of Employees by Province and Industry, Catalogue 72-514.
- (c) Monthly payroll derived from the surveys of employment and payroll in the federal, provincial and municipal governments.(2)

Separate monthly estimates of wages and salaries are prepared for each province for 18 industry groups (see below). The last annual estimates are allocated to months and the resulting estimates for the month of November are projected to current months using related indicators. Over the years the methods of building up the indicators have changed but generally the same main sources were used.

The indicators used to allocate benchmark data to months and to project from November 1975 to obtain 1976 data, are shown below for the 18 groups for which separate provincial estimates are prepared:

Le revenu du travail est la compensation versée aux salariés pour les services qu'ils rendent. Il comprend les salaires et traitements et le revenu supplémentaire du travail des résidents du Canada (les Canadiens employés par le gouvernement fédéral à l'étranger sont considérés comme des résidents du Canada), à l'exception des membres des Forces armées canadiennes. La rémunération de ces derniers répond à la définition du revenu du travail, mais elle n'est pas comprise ici parce qu'elle forme un poste distinct dans les Comptes nationaux.

Les salaires et traitements comprennent les jetons de présence des administrateurs, les gratifications et les commissions, ainsi que les allocations et les prestations imposables. Le revenu du travail est fondé sur des chiffres bruts: la rémunération est donc établie avant déduction de l'impôt sur le revenu, des cotisations d'assurance-chômage, à des caisses de retraite, etc. Le revenu supplémentaire du travail (paiements faits par l'employeur pour l'avantage futur de ses salariés) comprend les cotisations des employeurs aux caisses de retraite et aux régimes de prévoyance des salariés y compris le Régime de pensions du Canada et le Régime de rentes du Québec, aux caisses d'indemnisation des accidents du travail et à l'assurance-chômage.

La méthode générale utilisée dans la préparation des estimations du revenu du travail consiste à établir des données annuelles ou de référence, par province, pour certaines branches d'activité économique, et à répartir ces données par mois.

Les estimations annuelles sont fondées dans la plupart des cas sur des données tirées d'enquêtes exhaustives ou par échantillon, menées mensuellement ou annuellement par Statistique Canada, des recensements décennaux et quinquennaux du Canada et des comptes publics des administrations fédérale et provinciales. Ces estimations sont rectifiées à la lumière des déclarations que les employeurs transmettent au ministère du Revenu national et qui donnent une idée assez juste du total des salaires et traitements définis plus haut.

Les principaux indicateurs utilisés pour interpoler et extrapoler les données de recensement, pour projeter les données annuelles et pour répartir les données nationales par province sont les suivantes:

- a) Indice de la rémunération dans les grandes entreprises(1).
- b) Nombre de salariés calculé pour la publication Estimations du nombre de salariés par province et par industrie, no 72-514 au catalogue.
- c) Rémunérations mensuelles indiquées lors d'enquêtes sur l'emploi et la rémunération dans les administrations fédérale, provinciales et municipales(2).

Il est établi des estimations mensuelles des salaires et traitements pour chaque province pour 18 branches d'activité économique (voir ci-dessous). Les dernières estimations annuelles sont réparties par mois et les estimations qui en découlent pour novembre sont projetées pour les mois courants à l'aide des indicateurs pertinents. Les méthodes de construction des indicateurs ont changé au long des années, mais les principales sources sont demeurées les mêmes en général.

The monthly estimates of wages and salaries are measures of payments that would be received if workers were paid at the end of "months" consisting of approximately four and one-third weeks each. This is because most projectors used, i.e., the provincial payroll indexes by industry of large firms(1) are on a weekly basis. Other projectors are adjusted, as required, to eliminate fluctuations caused by variations in the number of working and/or pay days during the month.

Statistical Presentation

The latest monthly figures are advance estimates based on a limited number of early returns of employment reports. They have a lesser degree of reliability than the estimates for the immediately preceding month and the previous month which are based on more complete information. Estimates for other months and those for recent years are revised as new annual data become available.

The monthly figures in this report are presented to the nearest tenth of a million dollars. This is done in order to avoid sudden changes in estimates for small provinces or industries which would occur if the figures were rounded to the nearest million. It should not be assumed that the estimates are necessarily accurate to the nearest tenth of a million.

Estimates of labour income based on the 1948 Standard Industrial Classification have been published from 1926 to 1969 and are available on request from the Monthly Employment, Payrolls and Labour Income Section, Statistics Canada. Those based on the 1960 Standard Industrial Classification were originally published in 1969 for the period 1951-1968. These estimates were projected to the end of 1971. The entire series (1951-1971) has been revised and carried back to 1947.

The estimates for the last four years are revised each year to incorporate the latest annual data available. The estimates contained in this publication are as follows:

- (a) Annual and monthly estimates for the industries for Canada and by province of which the estimates for 1971 are considered final and those for 1972 to date are preliminary;
- (b) final estimates not contained in this publication are available back to 1947 on request to the Monthly Employment, Payrolls and Labour Income Section, Statistics Canada.

Although the monthly estimates of wages and salaries are derived for 18 industry groups by province, publication or release of the provincial industry estimates are subject to confidentiality and reliability constraints. The criteria used for selection of industry data by province for publication were based on the level and proportion of the employment series of the source used to derive the wages and salaries estimate to the total estimated employment for that industry. For some provinces, certain industries were combined such that the constraints would be met.

The tables contain a few groupings not found in the Standard Industrial Classification. These include:

Goods-producing industry — The sum of agriculture, fishing, hunting and trapping, forestry, mining, manufacturing, and construction industries.

Les estimations mensuelles des salaires et traitements sont une mesure des sommes que toucheraient les travailleurs s'ils étaient payés à la fin de "mois" composés d'à peu près quatre semaines et un tiers chacun. C'est que la plupart des projecteurs utilisés, c.-à-d. les indices de rémunérations par province et par branche pour les grandes entreprises(1) sont établis sur une base hebdomadaire. Les autres projecteurs sont rectifiés, au besoin, pour éliminer les fluctuations dues à la variation du nombre de jours ouvrages et/ou de jours de paye pendant le mois.

Présentation statistique

Les plus récents chiffres mensuels sont des estimations préliminaires fondées sur un échantillon limité des premières déclaration d'emploi reçues. Ils ne sont pas aussi fiables que les estimations visant le dernier et l'avant-dernier mois, qui sont basées sur des renseignements plus complets. Les estimations des autres mois et des années récentes sont rectifiées à mesure que les nouvelles autres données annuelles sont disponibles.

Les chiffres mensuels publiés ici sont établis au dixième de million de dollars près. Cela permet d'éviter les changements subits qui se produiraient dans le cas des petites provinces ou des petites branches si ces chiffres étaient arrondis au million. Il ne faut pas supposer que les estimations sont nécessairement exactes au dixième de million près.

Les estimations du revenu du travail fondées sur la Standard Industrial Classification de 1948 ont été publiées de 1926 à 1969 et sont disponibles sur demande à la Section de l'emploi, de la rémunération et du revenu du travail, Statistique Canada. Les estimations basées sur la Classification type des industries de 1960 ont été publiées d'abord en 1969 pour la période 1951-1968. Ces estimations ont fait l'objet de projections jusqu'à la fin de 1971. La série entière (1951-1971) a été rectifiée et reportée à 1947.

Les estimations des quatre années les plus récentes sont rectifiées annuellement à la lumière des dernières données annuelles disponibles. Cette publication contient les estimations suivantes:

- a) Estimations annuelles et mensuelles pour les branches d'activité au Canada et par province, les estimations de 1971 étant définitives et celles pour la période de 1972 à aujourd'hui, provisoires;
- b) on peut se procurer les estimations définitives depuis 1947 qui ne figurent pas ici en s'adressant à la Section de l'emploi, de la rémunération et du revenu du travail, Statistique Canada.

Bien que les estimations mensuelles des salaires et traitements soient calculées pour 18 branches d'activité économique par province, la publication ou la diffusion des estimations provinciales sont soumises à la fiabilité et à la confidentialité. Les critères de sélection des données relatives à une activité économique par province et destinées à la publication sont basés sur le niveau et sur la proportion des effectifs de la source utilisée pour le calcul des estimations des salaires et traitements par rapport à l'effectif total estimatif de cette activité économique. Pour quelques provinces, on a fusionné certaines activités économiques afin de respecter les restrictions susmentionnées.

Les tableaux contiennent quelques branches qui ne figurent pas dans la Classification des activités économiques, notamment:

Industrie de biens — Englobe l'agriculture, la pêche, la chasse et le piégeage, les forêts, les mines, les industries manufacturières et la construction.

Service-producing industry — The sum of transportation, communication, and other utilities, trade, finance, insurance, and real estate, community, business and personal service, and public administration and defence industries.

Domestic services — The sum of babysitters, private duty nurses, and private households industries.

- (1) Employment and earnings data in firms employing at least 20 employees during the last seven days of any month of the year are collected and tabulated each month. The payroll index referred to here is derived from the gross earnings tabulated from these reports for the last pay period of the month adjusted to represent the whole month. Gross earnings include salaries, straight time wages, piecework and regular commission earnings, regularly paid incentive, cost of living and other bonuses, overtime earnings and payments to persons absent with pay in the survey week. Average weekly earnings is obtained by dividing gross earnings as defined above by the number of employees reported for the same period. Further detail regarding concepts, methodology, coverage and data tabulated from this survey will be found in a current issue of Employment, Earnings and Hours, Catalogue 72-002.
- (2) The results of these surveys are published in Federal Government Employment, Catalogue 72-004, Provincial Government Employment, Catalogue 72-007 and Local Government Employment, Catalogue 72-009.
