GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as General Fund activities. This comprehends the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale to governments or to others, making a direct charge for goods and services.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS PAYROLLS: Payrolls reported are the gross payrolls of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JANUARY - MARCH 1968

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April - June 1967

Data of the Departmental Services, Government Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Board of the Province of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institutions of Higher Education are included.

Cumulative payrolls (available for inclusion in this report) for the period January 1 - March 31, 1968, amounted to \$433.5 million, 1.1 p.c., down from the \$438.1 million reported for the previous quarter, October - December, 1967. Payrolls reported for the same period in 1967 were \$361.5 million indicating an increase over the year of 19.9 p.c. The number of employees reported for the last pay period in March, 1968 was 306,887, a 1.0 p.c., decrease from the 308,567 reported for the same period in December, 1967 and a 10.2 p.c., increase over the 278,231 reported for the last pay period in March 1967.

The gross payrolls reported for (1) Departmental Services (\$257.3) million, and (2) Provincial Government Enterprises (\$119.6) million for the period January 1 - March 31, 1968, decreased respectively from the previous quarter by 1.0 p.c. and 2.8 p.c. These decreases are the result of seasonal activities in the following functions: "Transportation and Communications", "Recreational and Cultural" and "Natural Resources and Primary Industries".

The Institutions of Higher Education reported gross payrolls of \$51.2 million. Workmen's Compensation Boards reported gross payrolls of \$5.4 million. These figures reflect an increase of 1.3 p.c. in Institutions of Higher Education payrolls and 4.5 p.c. in Workmen's Compensation Boards over the previous quarter. These increases are the result of (1) additional staff reported and (2) the increased cost of government services.

Total payrolls of provincial employees for the period April 1, 1967 to March 31, 1968 amounted to \$1,687.1 million. Employees in Departmental Services were paid \$999.7 or 59.2 p.c. of the total, the gross payrolls of the staff of Institutions of Higher Education amounted to \$191.7 million or 11.4 p.c. The employees of Provincial Government Enterprises received \$475.3 million or 28.2 p.c., while the staff of Workmen's Compensation Boards were paid \$20.4 million or 1.2 p.c., of the total.

Table 13. Gross payrolls are included in this issue for the first time by Type of Organization for the fiscal years ending March 31, 1962 to 1968 inclusive. The total of \$1,687.1 million for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1968 is an increase of 101.5 p.c. over the corresponding total of \$837.4 million for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1962. These figures represent the gross salaries, wages, retroactive salary increases and overtime payments made in each period. Compilations were prepared from the monthly reports of data received from each of the participating governments with the exception of the Province of Quebec for the fiscal years 1962 to 1965; data for these years were compiled from the Province of Quebec Public Accounts. This table will be included annually in the first quarterly report.
