

GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as General Fund activities. This comprises the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale to governments or to others, making a direct charge for goods and services.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS PAYROLLS: Payrolls reported are the gross payrolls of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JULY - SEPTEMBER 1968

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April - June 1968.

Data of the Departmental Services, Government Enterprises, and Workmen's Compensation Board of the Province of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institutions of Higher Education in that Province are included.

The cumulative gross payrolls (excluding the Province of British Columbia as noted above) for the period July 1 - September 30, 1968 amounted to \$503.5 million an increase of 11.5 per cent over the \$451.4 million reported for the previous quarter April 1 - June 30, 1968. The number of employees reported for the last pay period in September was 339,674 an increase of 1.6 per cent from the 334,348 reported for the same period in June 1968. These increases are due primarily to the normal seasonal activities in the following functions: "General Government Services," "Transportation and Communications", "Natural Resources and Primary Industries" and the increase in cost of government services.

Gross payrolls reported for the provincial employees for the period January 1 to September 30, 1968 amounted to \$1,388.5 million. Employees in Departmental Services received \$813.2 million or 58.6 per cent of the total, the staff of the Institutions of Higher Education were paid \$163.0 million or 11.5 per cent. The employees of Provincial Government Enterprises received \$395.4 million or 28.5 per cent, while those of the Workmen's Compensation Boards were paid \$16.9 million or 1.2 per cent of the total.
