

GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as General Fund activities. This comprises the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale to governments or to others, making a direct charge for goods and services.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS PAYROLLS: Payrolls reported are the gross payrolls of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April - June 1968.

Data of the Departmental Services, Government Enterprises, and Workmen's Compensation Board of the Province of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institutions of Higher Education in that Province are included.

The number of employees relates to employment on the last day of the month or at the end of the final pay period of the month. The payrolls represent all monies paid to employees during the period before any deductions for income tax etc. Retroactive and overtime payments are included in the month the payments are made.

The gross payrolls of the provincial government employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the October 1 - December 31-1968 quarter amounted to \$506.4 million an increase of 0.5 per cent over the \$504.1 million reported for the previous quarter July 1 - September 30-1968. This increase resulted from the payment of retroactive salary increases covering the period from April 1968 to November 1968.

The number of employees reported for the last pay period in December 1968 was 326,338 a decrease of 3.1 per cent from the 336,857 reported for the same period in September 1968. This is a normal decrease resulting from the seasonal reduction of wage earning employees in the "Transportation and Communication" "Recreational and Cultural Services (Parks)" "Natural Resources and Primary Industries" Functions.

Total payrolls reported for the provincial government employees for the period January 1 to December 31-1968 amounted to \$1,910.1 million. Employees in the Departmental Services were paid \$1,115.4 million or 58.4 per cent while those of the Institutions of Higher Education, the Provincial Enterprises and the Workmen's Compensation Boards respectively received \$223.9 million or 11.7 per cent, \$547.3 million or 28.7 per cent and \$23.4 million or 1.2 per cent of the total.

Due to unavoidable delays in the reporting of monthly data, estimates have been made for some departments for the month of December 1968. Revised totals will be published in the next quarterly report.




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
