GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as General Fund activities. This comprises the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale to governments or to others, making a direct charge for goods and services.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS PAYROLLS: Payrolls reported are the gross payrolls of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April - June 1969.

Data of the Departmental Services, Government Enterprises, and Workmen's Compensation Board of the Province of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institutions of Higher Education in that province are included.

The number of employees relates to employment on the last day of the month or at the end of the final pay period of the month. The payrolls represent all monies paid to employees during the period before any deductions for income tax etc. Retroactive and overtime payments are included in the month the payments are made.

The gross payrolls of the provincial government employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the fourth quarter 1969, amounted to \$569.2 million a slight decrease from the \$569.6 million reported for the previous quarter of July - September 1969. The fourth quarter totals include an additional pay period for those employees who are paid on a Bi-Weekly basis.

The number of employees reported for the last pay period in December 1969 was 337,851 a decrease of 4.5 per cent from the 353,837 reported for the same period in September 1969. This decrease was the result of the normal seasonal reduction of part-time employees in both the salary and the wage earning categories.

Total gross payrolls reported for the provincial government employees for the calendar year January 1 to December 31, 1969 amounted to \$2,155.1 million. Employees in the Departmental Services were paid \$1,266.1 million (58.7%) while those of the Institutions of Higher Education, the Provincial ~~and~~ government Enterprises, and Workmen's Compensation Boards respectively received : million (16.5%), \$508.0 million (23.6%), and \$25.4 million (1.2%) of the total. 12.4% 59.0




