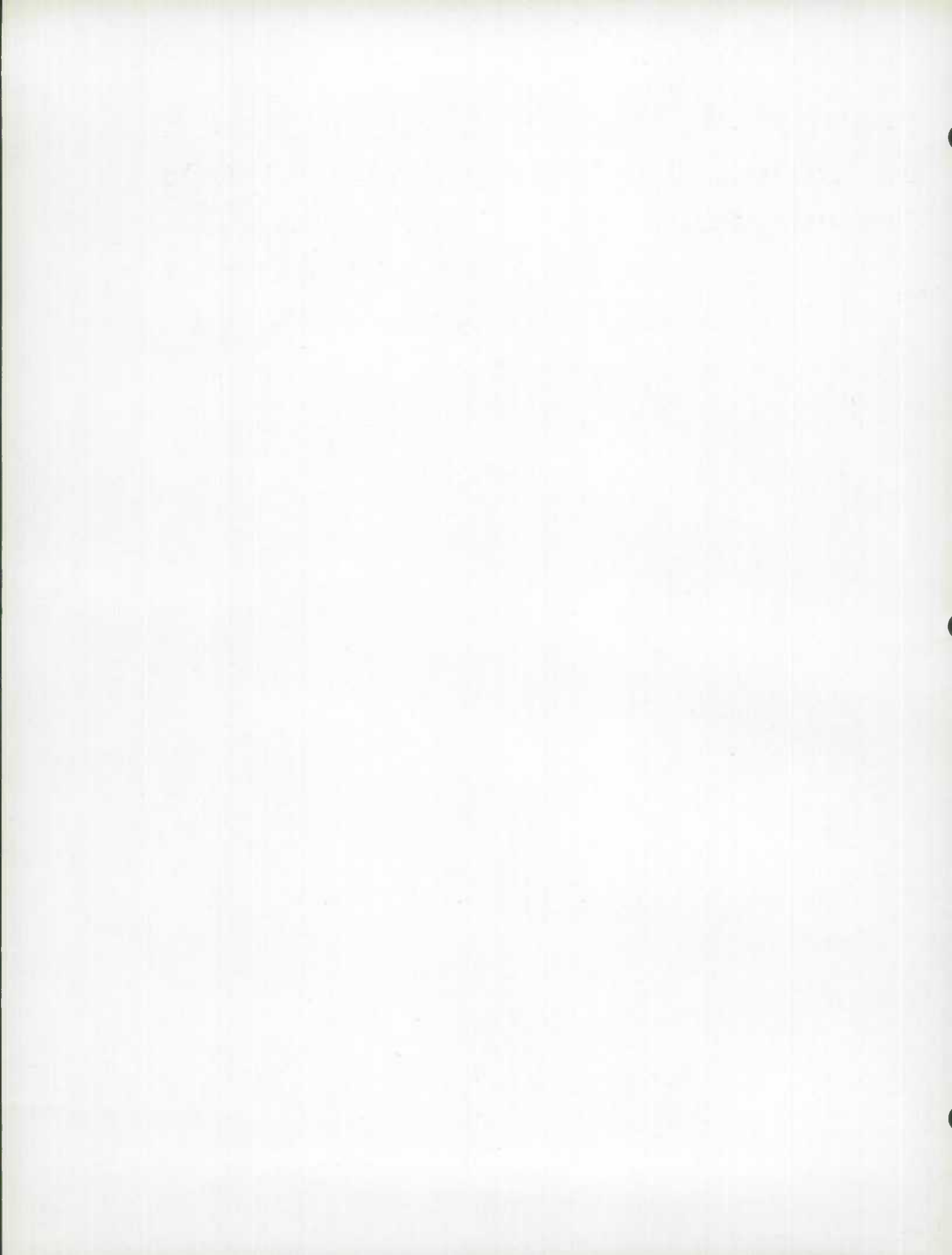

GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

Salary Earners

Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

Wage Earners

Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

Full-Time Wage Earners

Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

Other Wage Earners

Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

Number of Employees

Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

Gross Payrolls

Payrolls reported are the gross payrolls of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and overtime payments.

DÉFINITION DES PRINCIPAUX TERMES UTILISÉS

Employés à traitement

Personnes qui touchent un traitement sur une base mensuelle ou annuelle. Ces emplois peuvent être permanents, à terme saisonniers, de session ou à temps partiel.

Employés à salaire

Employés qui sont payés à l'heure, à la journée ou à la semaine.

Employés à salaire à plein-temps

Personnes qui occupent un emploi permanent à plein temps.

Autres employés à salaire

Employés à salaire qui n'occupent pas d'emplois permanents et à plein temps (saisonniers, à temps partiel et intermittents).

Nombre d'employés

Représente le nombre de personnes qui figurait sur la dernière feuille de paye du mois.

Rémunération brute

La rémunération déclarée indique la paye brute de toutes les personnes payées pour le travail fait durant le mois qu'elles soient inscrites ou non sur la liste de paye à la fin du mois. Cela inclut les payes rétroactives, les ajustements de salaires et les paiements de temps supplémentaire.

INTRODUCTION

This publication provides a summary of the number of employees and the gross payrolls of the governments of the Canadian provinces and the Yukon and Northwest Territories. (Only partial data are available at this time for the Province of British Columbia.) The data are presented on a monthly basis with quarterly totals.

The purpose of this survey of provincial government employment is to (1) provide statistics on the provincial government component of the national labour force and national accounts income and expenditure series, (2) provide governments with figures which will serve their needs for statistical measurements of employment, (3) make such data available to research groups, students and the general public.

An analysis of the general government services (as detailed in The Canadian System of Government Financial Management Statistics, Catalogue 68-506) is given by "function". This analysis is useful in three ways. First, it permits a detailed study of the employment in each province according to major functions or purposes. Since these functions are not altered by changes in administrative structure which occur from time to time, they permit the development of a series which is consistent, with minor changes, over an extended period. Second, since differences in administrative establishment do not seriously affect a functional classification, it is possible to measure employment in comparable terms between provinces as well as between various levels of government. Third, this classification permits analysis, for each function, of the relationship between expenditures on employment and total expenditures.

Coverage

Data in the report consist of two major groups as follows:

1. Provincial general government services, in this publication are comprised of
 - (a) departments of government;
 - (b) administrative, regulatory and special funds which perform functions similar to those of departments and which may be organized as boards, commissions or agencies;
 - (c) government-owned and financially supported institutions such as those engaged in education, health and welfare services or in the administration of justice.

2. Provincial government enterprises

A provincial government enterprise is an organized entity, usually corporate, which (a) is established by a political decision-making body to produce goods and/or services for sale on the open market at a price related to costs, (b) maintains an independent system of accounts that permits the charging of specific elements of costs against the revenue derived from its sale of goods and/or services, (c) has a relatively autonomous management in the conduct of day-to-day operations, and (c) is staffed by personnel not normally subject to the statutory requirements governing employment in the general public service.

For a more complete explanation of the general government and the government enterprise universe refer to the Statistics Canada publication entitled The Canadian System of Government Financial Management Statistics (Catalogue 68-506).

La présente publication offre un état sommaire de l'emploi et de la rémunération brute dans les administrations publiques des provinces canadiennes, du Yukon et des Territoires du Nord-Ouest. (Seules des données partielles sont disponibles actuellement pour la Colombie-Britannique.) Les données sont présentées sur une base mensuelle avec des totaux trimestriels.

L'objet de cette enquête sur l'emploi dans l'administration publique provinciale est (1) de fournir des statistiques sur l'apport des administrations publiques provinciales à la population active du Canada et aux séries des comptes nationaux sur le revenu et la dépense, (2) de fournir aux administrations publiques des chiffres qui répondront aux besoins qu'elles ont de prendre la mesure statistique de l'emploi, et (3) de mettre ces données à la disposition des groupes de recherche, des étudiants et du grand public.

Une analyse des services généraux de l'administration publique (telle que détaillée dans Le système canadien des statistiques de la gestion financière des administrations publiques, (n° 68-506F au catalogue) est donnée par "fonction". Cette analyse sert à trois fins. Premièrement, elle permet une étude détaillée de l'emploi dans chaque province selon les principales fonctions ou fins. Étant donné que ces fonctions ne subissent pas le contre-coup des changements qui se produisent de temps à autre dans la structure administrative, elles permettent de mettre au point une série uniforme, sauf pour des changements mineurs, qui s'étend sur une longue période de temps. Deuxièmement, vu que les différences dans l'administration ne touchent pas sérieusement une classification fonctionnelle, il est possible d'évaluer l'emploi en termes comparables aussi bien entre provinces qu'entre divers niveaux d'administration. Troisièmement, cette classification permet, pour chaque fonction, une analyse du rapport qui existe entre les dépenses de main-d'œuvre et l'ensemble des dépenses.

Champ de l'enquête

Les données du bulletin se rapportent aux deux principaux groupes suivants:

1. Les services généraux des administrations publiques provinciales qui comprennent, dans la présente publication
 - (a) les ministères;
 - (b) les fonds administratifs, réglementaires et spéciaux dont les fonctions sont semblables à celles des ministères et qui peuvent être constitués en conseils, commissions ou organismes.
 - (c) les établissements qui appartiennent à l'administration provinciale ou qui en dépendent financièrement, tels que ceux qui se consacrent à l'éducation, aux services de santé et de bien-être ou à l'administration de la justice.

2. Entreprises publiques provinciales

Une entreprise publique provinciale est un tout organisé, habituellement constitué en société, et (a) qui est établi par une décision d'un corps politique pour produire des biens et (ou) des services destinés à la vente sur le marché libre à un prix en relation avec les coûts, (b) qui tient un système indépendant de comptes lui permettant d'imputer des éléments spécifiques des coûts au revenu provenant de la vente de biens et (ou) de services, (c) qui possèdent une administration relativement autonome pour la conduite des affaires au jour le jour, et (c) qui compte à son service un personnel non assujéti d'ordinaire aux exigences statutaires qui régissent l'emploi dans la fonction publique.

Pour de plus amples explications sur les administrations publiques en général et sur l'univers des entreprises publiques, veuillez consulter la publication de Statistique Canada intitulée Le système canadien des statistiques de la gestion financière des administrations publiques (n° 69-506F au catalogue).

Comparability Between Numbers and Earnings

The user of these statistics is advised to avoid making direct comparison between the numbers of employees reported and the payrolls reported, the reason for this being that numbers relate to the last day of the month wherever possible and otherwise to the final pay period of the month. Since in certain categories, especially casual employment, considerable fluctuations in numbers employed occur during a month it will be seen that a comparison between the payrolls of all persons employed during the month and the number on strength at the end of the month would, in many cases, not be valid.

Comparabilité entre le nombre d'employés et la rémunération

Les utilisateurs de ces données doivent éviter de faire des comparaisons directes entre le nombre d'employés et leur rémunération; en effet, le nombre d'employés est saisi le dernier jour du mois, dans tous les cas possibles, dans les autres cas, il est saisi pendant la dernière période de paie du mois. Comme dans certaines catégories (surtout chez les employés occasionnels), il se produit d'importantes fluctuations du nombre d'employés au cours d'un mois, la comparaison entre la rémunération brute de toutes les personnes employées au cours du mois et les effectifs à la fin du mois serait, dans bien des cas, erronée.

Explanatory Comments

General Government Services

The cumulative gross payrolls reported by the provincial and territorial governments (excluding British Columbia as noted) for the fourth quarter of 1973 amounted to \$659.3 million an increase of 3.3% from the \$637.5 million reported for the previous quarter of July-September 1973. The number of employees reported for the last pay period in December 1973 was 314,794 a decrease of 1.3% over the 318,525 reported for the same pay period in September 1973. The increase in the gross payrolls of 3.3% is the result of an additional pay period for those employees paid on bi-weekly basis.

Due to unavoidable delays in the reporting of monthly data, estimates have been made for some departments. Revised totals will be published in the next quarterly report.

Texte explicatif

Administration publique générale

La rémunération brute (excluant la Colombie-Britannique comme mentionné ci-haut) pour le quatrième trimestre de l'année 1973 atteignait \$659.3 millions, soit une augmentation de 3.3 % par rapport aux \$637.5 millions du trimestre précédent, écoulé entre juillet-septembre 1973. Le nombre d'employés déclarés à la fin de décembre 1973 était de 314,794 soit une augmentation de 1.3 % par rapport aux 318,525 déclarés à la fin de septembre 1973. L'augmentation dans la rémunération brute de 3.3 % est le résultat; (1) d'une période de paye supplémentaire reçue par les employés rémunérés sur une base bi-hebdomadaire.

À cause de délais inévitables dans la transmission des données mensuelles, des nombres ont dû être estimés pour quelques ministères. Les rectifications qui s'imposent apparaîtront dans le prochain rapport trimestriel.

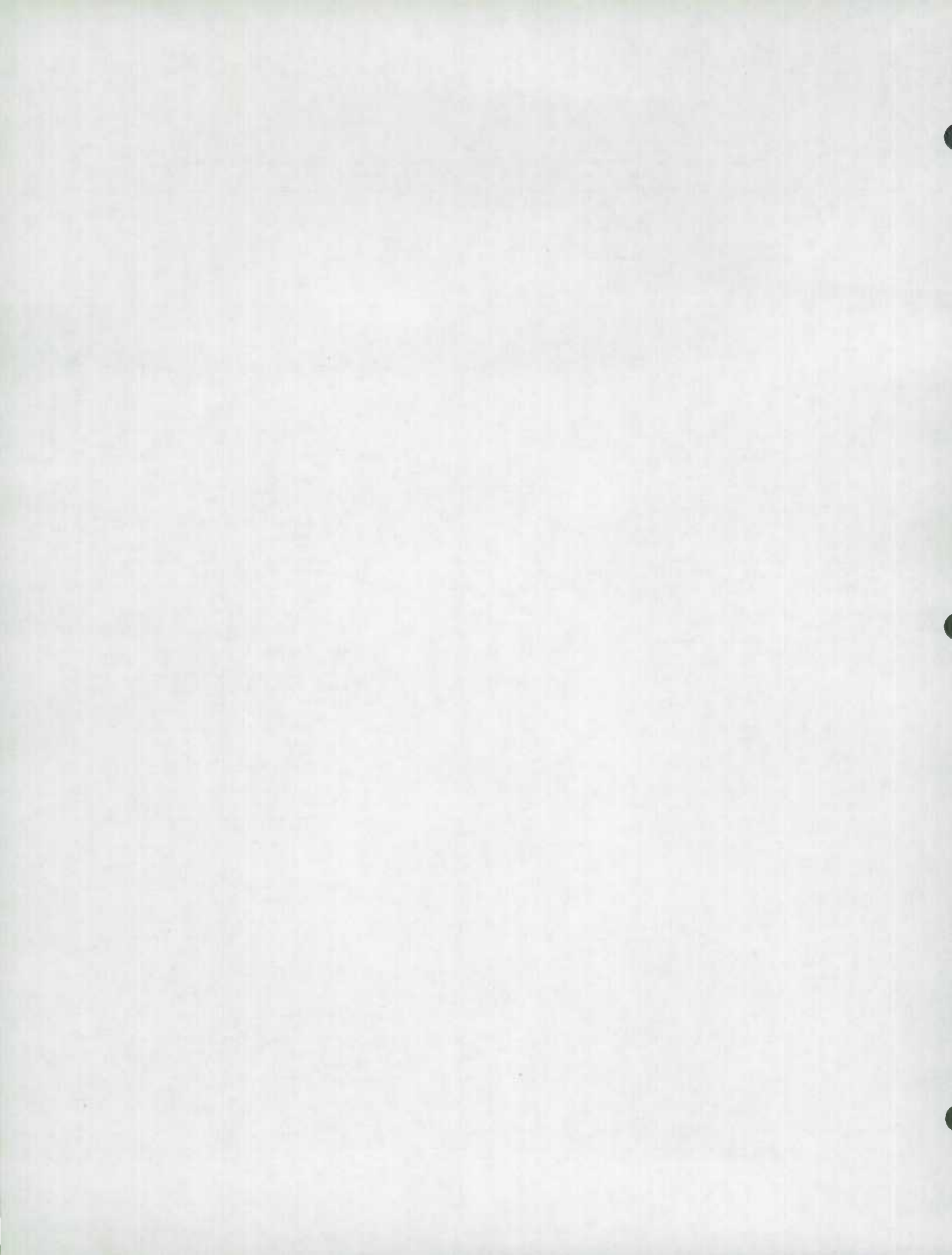

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISE

ENTREPRISES PUBLIQUES PROVINCIALES

A provincial government enterprise is an organized entity, usually corporate, which (a) is established by a political decision-making body to produce goods and/or services for sale on the open market at a price related to costs, (b) maintains an independent system of accounts that permits the charging of specific elements of costs against the revenue derived from its sale of goods and/or services, (c) has a relatively autonomous management in the conduct of day-to-day operations, and (d) is staffed by personnel not normally subject to the statutory requirements governing employment in the general public service.

Une entreprise publique provinciale est un tout organisé, habituellement constitué en société, et a) qui est établi par une décision d'un corps politique pour produire des biens et (ou) des services destinés à la vente sur le marché libre à un prix en relation avec les coûts, b) qui tient un système indépendant de comptes lui permettant d'imputer des éléments spécifiques des coûts au revenu provenant de la vente de biens et (ou) de services, c) qui possède une administration relativement autonome pour la conduite des affaires au jour le jour, et d) qui compte à son service un personnel non assujéti d'ordinaire aux exigences statutaires qui régissent l'emploi dans la fonction publique.
