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

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JULY - SEPTEMBER 1961

A review of totals indicates that the number and gross earnings of employees were considerably higher during the quarter ended September 30, 1961 than for the April - June 1961 quarter.

This resulted primarily from increased seasonal activities in various functions for the following reasons:

Transportation and Communications - Although there were fewer persons employed at the end of this quarter than the previous one, the total payroll expenditure increased by approximately \$4,000,000. This was due to increased employment for road construction and maintenance during most of the quarter.

Health and Social Welfare - An increase in employees and payroll expenditure which was due primarily to the additional hospital services being provided by various provincial governments and the employment of casual staff as holiday replacements.

There was also a substantial increase in "Recreation and Cultural Services" because of the employment of summer staffs in connection with recreation and parks.

The services which comprise the "Natural Resources and Primary Industries" function also show an increase, chiefly because of the additional requirement for fire-fighters in the forests.

Data for the departmental services and enterprises of Quebec and British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this report.

The 180,968 employees reported for September, 1961 (excluding the Yukon Territory) represented a 4.3 per cent increase over September, 1960 (173,502) and a 1.3 per cent increase over June, 1961 (178,634).

Earnings (excluding the Yukon Territory) for the July 1 - September 30, 1961 quarter totalled \$172,702,000; a gain of 6.5 per cent from the July - September, 1960 quarter (\$162,188,000) and 7.8 per cent from the April - June, 1961 quarter (\$160,227,000). Total earnings of provincial employees for the period January 1 - September 30, 1961 amounted to \$485,707,000 (\$484,959,000 excluding the Yukon Territory). Employees in Departmental Services earned \$280,079,000 or 57.6 per cent of the total while Enterprise staffs earned \$154,716,000 or 31.9 per cent and those of Institutions of Higher Education received \$50,911,000 or 10.5 per cent.

A complete description of the statistics included in this series is given together with other background detail in the Provincial Government Employment report for the April - June 1961 quarter.

GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as the General Fund activities. This comprehends the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale to governments or to others, making a direct charge for goods and services.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS EARNINGS: Earnings are the gross earnings of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not and include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.


