



PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

OCTOBER - DECEMBER 1961

A review of totals indicates that the number and gross earnings of employees were considerably lower during the quarter ended December 31, 1961 than for the July - September 1961 quarter.

This resulted mainly from reduced activity in the following services which normally employ large numbers of part-time or seasonal wage earners:

Transportation and Communications - Decrease in road construction and below-normal requirements for snow removal.

Recreation and Cultural Services - Seasonal decrease in out-door recreation facilities.

Natural Resources and Primary Industries - Termination of seasonal tree-planting jobs and fighting services.

Data for the departmental services and enterprises of Quebec and British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this report.

The 169,839 employees reported for December, 1961 (excluding the Yukon Territory) represented a 1.6 per cent increase over December, 1960 (167,086) and a 5.9 per cent decrease from September, 1961 (180,412).

Earnings (excluding the Yukon Territory) for the October 1 - December 31, 1961 quarter totalled \$164,040,000; a gain of 4.1 per cent from the October - December, 1960 quarter (\$157,593,000) and 5.0 per cent decrease from the July - September, 1961 quarter (\$172,702,000). Total earnings of provincial employees for the year 1961 amounted to \$650,140,000 (\$648,999,000 excluding the Yukon Territory). Employees in Departmental Services earned \$375,812,000 or 57.8 per cent of the total while Enterprise staffs earned \$205,113,000 or 31.6 per cent and those of Institutions of Higher Education received \$69,215,000 or 10.6 per cent.

A complete description of the statistics included in this series is given together with other background detail in the Provincial Government Employment report for the April - June 1961 quarter.

GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as General Fund activities. This comprehends the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale to governments or to others, making a direct charge for goods and services.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS EARNINGS: Earnings reported are the gross earnings of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.


