PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JANUARY - MARCH 1962

A review of totals indicates that the number and gross earnings of employees were slightly lower during the quarter ended March 31, 1962 than for the October - December 1961 quarter.

Data for the departmental services and enterprises of Quebec and British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this report.

The 165,007 employees reported for March 1962 (excluding the Yukon Territory) represented a 3.1 per cent increase over March 1961 (160,089) and a 2.8 per cent decrease from December 1961 (169,839).

Earnings (excluding the Yukon Territory) for the January 1 - March 31, 1962 quarter totalled \$163,193,000; a gain of 7.3 per cent from the January - March 1961 quarter (\$152,030,000) but a decrease of 0.5 per cent from the October - December 1961 quarter (\$164,040,000). Total earnings of provincial employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the fiscal year April 1, 1961 - March 31, 1962 amounted to \$661,668,000. Employees in Departmental Services earned \$384,254,000 or 58.1 per cent of the total while Enterprise staffs earned \$205,861,000 or 31.1 per cent and those of Institutions of Higher Education received \$71,553,000 or 10.8 per cent.

A complete description of the statistics included in this series is given together with other background detail in the Provincial Government Employment report for the April - June 1961 quarter.

GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as General Fund activities. This comprehends the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale to governments or to others, making a direct charge for goods and services.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS EARNINGS: Earnings reported are the gross earnings of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.


