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

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JULY - SEPTEMBER 1962

A review of totals indicates that the number and gross earnings of employees were considerably higher during the quarter ended September 30, 1962 than for the April - June 1962 quarter. This resulted primarily from increased seasonal activities in the "Transportation and Communications" and "Natural Resources" functions, and a general increase in Government Enterprises.

Data for the Departmental Services, Government Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Boards of Quebec and British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this report.

The 183,752 employees reported for September 1962 represented a 1.7 per cent increase over September 1961 (180,756) and a 2.5 per cent increase over June 1962 (179,274).

Earnings of employees for the July 1 - September 30, 1962 quarter totalled \$183,035,000; a gain of 5.8 per cent from the July - September 1961 quarter (\$173,050,000) and a gain of 9.4 per cent from the April - June 1962 quarter (\$167,373,000). Total earnings of provincial employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the period January 1 - September 30, 1962 amounted to \$513,965,000. Employees in Departmental Services earned \$298,848,000 or 58.2 per cent of the total while staff of Institutions of Higher Education received \$57,186,000 or 11.1 per cent. Those in Enterprises earned \$151,326,000 or 29.4 per cent and the Workmen's Compensation Board staffs received \$6,605,000 or 1.3 per cent.

Payroll in the July - September 1962 quarter was greater in all eight reporting provinces than in either the April-June 1962 or the July-September 1961 period. Employment rose in the departmental services of Newfoundland because of increased highways work, of Ontario due to forest service requirements and of Alberta because of increases in several departments. The departmental services of Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick had fewer employees mainly because their highways departments had fewer wage earners. The Universities of Saskatchewan and Alberta had substantially larger staffs, a reflection of their expanding educational facilities.


