Summary data for the Province of Quebec are now available but have not been included in the body of this report because function analyses cannot yet be produced. The following table indicates the detail presently available for the province.

Quebec information will continue to be limited to totals for the various services for some time. It is hoped, however, that detail by function will be available later in 1964.

Data for the Departmental Services, Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Board of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication but the Institutions of Higher Education are included.

The following commentary relates to data contained in the main tables of this report and, therefore, excludes reference to Quebec.

The number and gross earnings of employees were lower during the quarter ended March 31, 1964 than in the October-December 1963 quarter. This resulted primarily from (1) further decrease in seasonal activities in the "Transportation and Communication" and "Natural Resources" functions (2) decreases of 3.6 per cent in staff and 1.1 per cent in payrolls of "Government Enterprises".

The 179,688 employees reported for March 1964 represents a 5.5 per cent increase over March 1963 (170,386) and a 1.6 per cent decrease from December 1964 (182,657).

Earnings of employees for the January-March 1964 quarter totalled \$189,086,000 a gain of 9.3 per cent over January-March 1963 (\$173,056,000) but a decrease of 2.5 per cent from the October-December 1963 quarter (\$193,842,000). Payrolls associated with the Health and Social Welfare functions in Ontario decreased by \$1.36 million in the quarter. This decrease occurred because the December 1963 payroll was considerably higher than normal due to the inclusion of pay increases which dated back, in some cases, to September 1962.

Total earnings of provincial employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the fiscal year April 1, 1963 - March 31, 1964 amounted to \$762,968,000. Employees in Departmental Services earned \$444,028,000 or 58.2 per cent of the total, while staff of Institutions of Higher Education received \$91,444,000 or 12.0 per cent. Those in Enterprises earned \$218,078,000 or 28.6 per cent of the total and Workmen's Compensation Board staffs received \$9,418,000 or 1.2 per cent.
