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

Data for the Departmental Services, Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Board of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication but the Institutions of Higher Education are included.

The following commentary relates to data contained in the tables of this report and therefore, excludes any reference to Quebec.

The gross payrolls of employees were 1.5 p.c. lower during the quarter ended December 31, 1964 than in the July-September 1964 quarter. This was due primarily to decreased seasonal activities in the "Transportation and Communications" and "Natural Resources" functions.

The 192,409 employees reported for December 1964 was 5.3 per cent over December 1963 (182,657) and 3.2 per cent lower than in September 1964 (198,827).

Payrolls of employees for the October-December 1964 quarter totalled \$215.7 million a gain of 11.3 per cent over October-December 1963 \$193.8 million and a 1.5 per cent decrease from July-September 1964 \$219.0 million.

Total gross payrolls of provincial employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the calendar year 1964 amounted to \$824.0 million. Payrolls for employees in the Departmental Services were \$475.9 million or 57.8 per cent of the total while those of the Institutions of Higher Education received \$107.0 million or 13.0 per cent. The staff of Provincial Government Enterprises received 28.0 per cent of the total payroll or \$231.1 million and the Workmen's Compensation Board Staffs received \$10.0 million or 1.2 per cent. Total gross payrolls include retroactive pay, salary, adjustments, and overtime payments.
