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

Data for the Departmental Services, Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Board of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication but the Institutions of Higher Education are included.

The following commentary relates to data contained in the tables of this report and therefore, excludes any reference to Quebec.

The 190,238 employees reported for March 1965 was 5.9 per cent over March 1964 (179,688) and 1.1 per cent lower than in December 1964 (192,409).

Payrolls of employees for the January-March 1965 quarter totalled \$209.7 million a gain of 10.9 per cent over January-March 1964 \$189.1 million and a 2.8 per cent decrease from October-December 1964 \$215.6 million.

Total gross payrolls of provincial employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the fiscal year April 1, 1964 - March 31, 1965 amounted to \$844.6 million. Payrolls for employees in the Departmental Services were \$486.3 million or 57.6 per cent of the total while those of the Institutions of Higher Education received \$112.6 million or 13.3 per cent. The staff of Provincial Government Enterprises received 27.9 per cent of the total payroll or \$235.5 million and the Workmen's Compensation staffs received \$10.1 million or 1.2 per cent. Total gross payrolls include retroactive pay, salary, adjustments, and overtime payments.


