PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JULY - SEPTEMBER 1965

The gross payrolls of provincial government employees reached a new peak in the quarter ending September 30, 1965. This resulted primarily from: (1) the normal seasonal increases in the "Transportation and Communications" and "Natural Resources" functions; (2) the payment of retroactive salary increases by a number of the provincial governments and (3) an additional pay period occurring during this quarter for those employees that are paid on a fortnightly basis.

Data for Departmental Services, Government Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Boards of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institutions of Higher Education are included.

The 278,616 employees reported for September 1965 represents 4.3 per cent increase over September 1964 (267,091) and a 2.1 per cent increase from June 1965 (272,790).

Payrolls of employees for the July-September 1965 quarter totalled \$316.4 million a gain of 11.9 per cent over July-September 1964 (\$282.6 million) and of 10.7 per cent from April-June 1965 (\$285.7 million).

Total payrolls of provincial employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the period January 1 - September 30, 1965 amounted to \$867.9 million. Employees in Departmental Services earned \$518.4 million or 59.8 per cent of the total while staff of Institutions of Higher Education received \$93.8 million or 10.9 per cent. Those of Enterprises earned \$244.6 million or 28.1 per cent and Workmen's Compensation Board staffs received \$11.2 million or 1.2 per cent.


