PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

OCTOBER - DECEMBER 1965

The gross payrolls of provincial government employees were 2.0 p.c. lower during the quarter ended December 31, 1965 than in the July-September 1965 quarter. This was due primarily to decreased seasonal activities in the "Transportation and Communications", "Natural Resources" and "Recreation and Cultural Services" functions.

Data of Departmental Services, Government Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Board of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institutions of Higher Education are included.

The 267,730 employees reported for December 1965 represents 6.7 per cent increase over December 1964 (250,855) and a 3.9 per cent decrease from September 1965 (278,616).

Payrolls of employees for the October-December 1965 quarter totalled \$310.2 million, a gain of 11.6 per cent over October-December 1964 (\$277.9 million) and a decrease of 2.0 per cent from July-September 1965 (\$316.5 million).

Total payrolls of provincial employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the year 1965 amounted to \$1,178.3 million. Employees in Departmental Services earned \$702.6 million or 59.7 per cent of the total while staff of Institutions of Higher Education received \$128.9 million or 10.9 per cent. Those of Enterprises earned \$331.4 million or 28.1 per cent and Workmen's Compensation Board staffs received \$15.3 million or 1.3 per cent.


