

## PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JANUARY - MARCH 1966

The gross payrolls of provincial government employees were 4.1 p.c. lower during the quarter ended March 31, 1966 than in the October - December 1965 quarter. This was due primarily to decreased seasonal activities in the "Transportation and Communications", "Natural Resources" and "Recreation and Cultural Services" functions.

Data of Departmental Services, Government Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Board of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institutions of Higher Education are included. Functional data for the province of Quebec are included in Tables 9-10-11-12 for the first time commencing January 1, 1966.

The 257,175 employees reported for March 1966 represents 3.2 per cent increase over March 1965 (249,013) and a 3.9 per cent decrease from December 1965 (267,730).

Payrolls of employees for the January - March 1966 quarter totalled \$297.4 million, a gain of 10.7 per cent over January - March 1965 (\$265.5 million) and a decrease of 4.1 per cent from October - December 1965 (\$310.2 million).

Total payrolls of provincial employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the fiscal year April 1, 1965 to March 31, 1966 amounted to \$1,210. million. Employees in Departmental Services earned \$723.4 million or 59.8 per cent of the total while staff of Institutions of Higher Education received \$134.5 or 11.1 per cent. Those of Enterprises earned \$336.2 million or 27.8 per cent and Workmen's Compensation Board staffs received \$15.9 million or 1.3 per cent.

A complete description of the statistics included in this series is given together with other background detail in the Provincial Government Employment report for the April - June 1965 quarter.


