GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as General Fund activities. This comprehends the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale to governments or to others, making a direct charge for goods and services.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS PAYROLLS: Payrolls reported are the gross payrolls of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JULY - SEPTEMBER 1966

The gross payrolls of provincial government employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the period July 1 - September 30 amounted to \$365.6 millions, an increase of 14.3 per cent over the \$319.9 reported for the previous quarter April - June 1966. This resulted from (1) the payment of salary increases retroactive to January 1, 1966, and the effect of these increases on the regular monthly payrolls, (2) the normal seasonal increases in the "Transportation and Communication" "Recreation and Cultural Services" and "Natural Resources" functions, (3) an additional pay period occurring during this quarter for many employees who are paid on a fortnightly or weekly basis, (4) increases in the Provincial Government Enterprises can be attributed to extended services and increased activities of the provincial Hydro Electric Commissions.

Data for the Departmental Services, Government Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Boards of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institutions of Higher Education is included.

The 296,151 employees reported for September 1966 represents a 6.3 per cent increase over September 1965 (278,616) and a 2.7 per cent increase from June 1966 (288,438).

Total payrolls of provincial employees reported for the period January 1 - September 30, 1966, amounted to \$983.1 million. Employees in Departmental Services earned \$590.4 million or 60.1 per cent of the total, while staff of Institutions of Higher Education received \$108.6 million or 11.0 per cent. Those of Enterprises earned \$271.6 million or 27.6 per cent and Workmen's Compensation Board Staff received \$12.5 million or 1.3 per cent.


