## GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as General Fund activities. This comprehends the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale to governments or to others, making a direct charge for goods and services.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS PAYROLLS: Payrolls reported are the gross payrolls of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.

## PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

### NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April - June 1966

The gross payrolls of provincial government employees (available for inclusion in this report) reached an all time high of \$336.6 million for the October - December 31 quarter an increase of 18.1 per cent over the \$310.2 million, reported for the same period of 1965. The 289,263 employees reported for December 1966 represents a 8.0 per cent increase over December 1965 (267,730) and a 4.8 per cent decrease from September 1966 (295,831).

Data of the Departmental Services, Government Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Board of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institution of Higher Education are included.

The Departmental Services reported gross payrolls of \$215.0 million, a decrease of 2.0 per cent from the \$219.3 million reported for the previous quarter July - September 1966. This resulted from normal seasonal decreases in the "Transportation and Communications", "Recreation" and "Natural Resources" functions.

Gross payrolls reported for (1) Institutions of Higher Education (\$39.9) million, (2) Provincial Government Enterprises (\$107.0) million, (3) Workmen's Compensation Boards (\$4.7) million, increased respectively over the previous quarter by 1.6 per cent, 3.3 per cent, and 7.3 per cent. These increases are the result of (1) additional staff reported for the Institutions of Higher Education. (2) The payment of retroactive salary and wage increases and the effect of these increases in the cost of government services.

Total payrolls of provincial employees reported for the period January 1 - December 31, 1966 amounted to \$1,350.4 millions. Employees in Departmental Services earned \$806.0 million or 59.7 per cent of the total, while staff of the Institutions of Higher Education received \$148.6 million or 11.0 per cent. Those of the Government Enterprises earned \$378.6 millions or 28.0 per cent and Workmen's Compensation Boards received \$17.2 million or 1.3 per cent.
