

GLOSSARY OF PRINCIPAL TERMS USED

DEPARTMENTAL SERVICES: Also known as General Fund activities. This comprehends the activities carried on by provincial governments as reflected in their Estimates and in addition, expenditures on employment by special or administrative funds.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION: These are educational institutions at the university level which are under the control of the provincial government, but which are not administered under departmental authority.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ENTERPRISES: These produce goods and services for sale to governments or to others, making a direct charge for goods and services.

SALARY EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a salary based on monthly or annual rates of pay. These employees may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional or part-time nature.

WAGE EARNERS: Employees in receipt of a wage based on hourly, daily or weekly rates of pay.

FULL-TIME WAGE EARNERS: Employees who occupy a continuing full-time position.

OTHER WAGE EARNERS: Employees who do not occupy a continuing full-time position. Examples are: seasonal, part-time and casual wage earners.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES: Represents the number of persons on the payroll for the last pay period reported in each month.

GROSS PAYROLLS: Payrolls reported are the gross payrolls of all persons paid for work done during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. They include retroactive pay, salary adjustments and over-time payments.

PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT

JANUARY - MARCH 1967

NOTE

A complete description of the method of collection and the statistics included in this series is given, together with other background detail, in the report for April - June 1966

Data of the Departmental Services, Government Enterprises and Workmen's Compensation Board of the Province of British Columbia are not available for inclusion in this publication. Data for the Institution of Higher Education are included.

The gross payrolls of provincial government employees (available for inclusion in this report) for the period January 1 - March 31, 1967 amounted to \$357.7 million a decrease of 2.5 per cent from the \$366.6 million reported for the previous quarter October - December 1966, payrolls reported for the same period in 1966 were \$297.6 million indicating an increase over the year of 20.2 per cent. The number of employees reported for March 31, 1967 were 277,937 a decrease of 3.9 per cent over the 289,270 reported for the month of December 1966 and a 7.9 per cent increase over the 257,453 over March 31, 1966.

Cumulative payrolls for the fiscal year April 1, 1966 - March 31, 1967 totalled \$1,410.6 million 16.5 per cent above the \$1,210.3 million for the same period 1965-1966.

The 175,367 employees reported by the Departmental Services as of March 31, 1967 represents 7.2 per cent increase over the 163,537 for March 31, 1966 and a 5.2 per cent decrease from December 31, 1966 (184,985). Totalled payrolls for the quarterly period January 1, - March 31, 1967 amounted to \$212.7 million a 19.2 per cent increase over the \$178.4 million for the same period in 1966 and 1.1 per cent decrease from the \$214.9 million for the previous quarter October 1, - December 31, 1966. This was due primarily to decreased seasonal activities in the "Transportation and Communications", "Natural Resources" and "Recreational (Parks etc.)" functions.

Total payrolls of provincial employees reported for the period April 1, 1966 - March 31, 1967 amounted to \$1,410.6 million. Employees in Departmental Services earned \$840.3 or 59.6 per cent of the total, while staff of the Institutions of Higher Education received \$154.1 million or 10.9 per cent. Those of the Government Enterprises earned \$398.6 million or 28.2 per cent and Workmen's Compensation Boards received \$17.6 million or 1.3 per cent.

Due to unavoidable delays in reporting, estimates have been used for the month of March for some departments. Revised figures will be published in the next quarterly report.


