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
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COMMENTARY

First Estimates(1) - September 1982

Seasonally Adjusted

The first estimates of the number of employees for the Canada total⁽²⁾ of non-agricultural industries showed a 0.3% increase from August to September. All industry divisions contributed to the increase except mining (including milling), manufacturing, finance, insurance and real estate and the non-commercial sector of service which decreased. All provinces recorded gains except Newfoundland, New Brunswick and Quebec which showed declines.

Preliminary Estimates(1) - August 1982

Seasonally Adjusted

Preliminary data for August 1982 showed a 0.7% decrease from July at the Canada total⁽²⁾ of non-agricultural industries. All industry divisions contributed to the decrease except forestry and public administration and defence which increased. All provinces recorded declines except New Brunswick which increased. All provinces recorded declines except New Brunswick which showed an increase.

OBSERVATIONS

Premières estimations(1) - Septembre 1982

Chiffres désaisonnalisés

Les premières estimations du nombre de salariés pour l'ensemble⁽²⁾ des industries non agricoles du Canada démontrent une hausse de 0.3% d'août à septembre. Toutes les divisions de l'activité économique ont augmenté sauf les mines (y compris le broyage), les manufactures, les finances, assurances et immeuble et les services non-commerciaux qui ont diminué. Toutes les provinces ont enregistré des hausses à l'exception de Terre-Neuve, du Nouveau-Brunswick et du Québec qui ont diminué.

Les données provisoires pour août 1982 montrent une baisse de 0.7% au niveau de l'ensemble⁽²⁾ des industries non agricoles du Canada. 

CONCEPTS AND METHODS

Objectives

Estimates of number of employees are designed to measure the levels and month-to-month trends in total non-agricultural employment by industry and province.

Sources of Data

The estimates of the number of employees are compiled by combining data originating from the following sources:

Employment, payrolls and manhours survey. The largest single source is the monthly employment, payrolls and manhours survey of all firms employing 20 or more persons in any one month of the year. Data from this survey are compiled in extensive industrial and geographic detail and include average hours and earnings figures as well as employment indexes; these data are published separately.(1)

Employment sample survey. Firms employing fewer than 20 employees are surveyed monthly on a sample basis and are asked to report employment data only. The size of the sample prevents publication of employment estimates in any industrial and geographic details; data for this series are not published elsewhere.

Other employment surveys. Separate surveys of employment are conducted on a census basis in hospitals, in education institutions and related services as well as in religious and welfare organizations. Establishments are asked to report employment data only and these are not published elsewhere.

Public administration and defence. Data for public administration and defence are collected by the Public Finance Division of Statistics Canada; these data are published separately.(2)

Other employment data. Employment estimates for fishing and trapping and for private

CONCEPTS ET MÉTHODES

Objectifs

Les estimations du nombre de salariés visent à mesurer les niveaux et les tendances mensuelles de l'emploi non agricole global selon l'activité économique et la province.

Sources des données

On obtient les estimations du nombre de salariés en groupant les données tirées des sources suivantes:

Enquête sur l'emploi, la rémunération et les heures-hommes. La source la plus importante est l'enquête sur l'emploi, la rémunération et les heures-hommes réalisée auprès de toutes les entreprises qui emploient 20 personnes ou plus au cours d'un mois de l'année. Les données tirées de cette enquête sont totalisées en ventilées d'une façon très détaillée selon l'activité économique et le lieu géographique et elles comprennent les moyennes arithmétiques des heures et des gains ainsi que les indices de l'emploi; ces données sont publiées séparément(1).

Enquête-échantillon sur l'emploi. Les entreprises qui emploient moins de 20 salariés font l'objet d'une enquête-échantillon mensuelle et ne fournissent que des données sur l'emploi. La taille de l'échantillon empêche la publication détaillée de données estimatives sur l'emploi en ce qui concerne l'activité économique et le lieu géographique; ces données ne sont pas publiées séparément.

Autres enquêtes sur l'emploi. Des recensements distincts sont réalisés auprès des hôpitaux, des établissements d'enseignement et de services connexes, des organismes religieux et des œuvres de bienfaisance. On demande aux établissements de ne fournir que des données sur l'emploi et celles-ci ne sont pas publiées séparément.

Administration publique et défense. C'est la Division des finances publiques de Statistique Canada qui recueille des données sur l'administration publique et la défense; ces données sont publiées séparément(2).

Autres données sur l'emploi. Les estimations de l'emploi pour les catégories "pêche et piégeage"

household services are based on information obtained through the monthly Labour Force household sample survey(3) of Statistics Canada.

Universe

The universe of large and small firms for employment surveys is derived from a central file of employers maintained by Business Register and Profiling Division of Statistics Canada.

Coverage

The data in this publication cover all industries except agriculture and the military personnel component of national defence.

Industrial Classification

All firms are assigned to an industry on the basis of their principal activity. In instances where the firm is engaged in only one kind of industrial activity, the industrial classification is straight forward. Classification problems arise when a firm is active in more than one kind of classifiable industrial activity. This usually occurs when a firm operates more than one establishment. The establishment, typically a factory, mine, store or a similar unit is defined, for statistical purposes, as the smallest separate operating entity capable of reporting all elements of basic industrial data which permit the calculation of "census value added" or "gross mark up" or "gross profit" as well as data on employment and payrolls.

For purposes of detailed geographical statistics, the establishment is often subdivided into reporting units which, although not capable of reporting all basic industrial statistics, can report employment and payroll data for particular locations.

The industrial classification of the statistics contained in this report is based on the Standard Industrial Classification for 1960. A description of the various industries and group of industries is contained in the **Standard Industrial Classification Manual**, Catalogue 12-501E.

Geographical Classification

Survey reporting units are assigned to a province and, where applicable, to an urban

Univers

L'univers des grandes et des petites entreprises visées par les enquêtes sur l'emploi est établi à l'aide d'un registre central des employeurs tenu à jour par la Division des profils et des registres d'entreprises de Statistique Canada.

Champ de l'enquête

Les données de ce bulletin visent toutes les activités économiques à l'exception de l'agriculture et de la composante "personnel militaire" de la défense nationale.

Classement par activité économique

Toutes les entreprises appartiennent à une branche d'activité économique qui est déterminée en fonction de leur activité principale. Si l'entreprise n'exerce qu'un seul genre d'activité économique, le classement est simple. Les problèmes surviennent lorsqu'elle en exerce plus d'un, par exemple lorsqu'elle possède plus d'un établissement. À des fins statistiques, on définit l'établissement, qui consiste habituellement en une usine, une mine, un magasin ou une unité semblable, comme la plus petite unité constituant un ensemble d'exploitation distinct en mesure de déclarer tous les éléments de base relevant de la statistique des activités économiques qui permettent de calculer la "valeur ajoutée" ou la "majoration brute" ou le "bénéfice brut" ainsi que des données sur l'emploi et la rémunération.

Pour permettre d'obtenir des statistiques géographiques détaillées, l'établissement est souvent subdivisé en unités déclarantes qui, bien qu'elles ne puissent fournir toutes les statistiques de base, sont en mesure de déclarer des données sur l'emploi et la rémunération pour des endroits particuliers.

Le classement des statistiques présentées ici s'inspire de la Classification type des industries de 1960. Vous trouverez une description des diverses activités économiques et divers groupes d'activité économique dans la **Classification des activités économiques**, no 12-501F au catalogue.

Classement géographique

On attribue les unités déclarantes de l'enquête à une province et, s'il y a lieu, à une

area (based on a labour market concept). The employment estimates, however, are compiled and published at the provincial and national levels only.

Definitions

Reference period. Conceptually, the employment data refer to the last seven days in the specified month. In practice, few firms keep payroll records covering precisely this period. Therefore, firms are permitted to report for their last pay period or pay periods in each month. When the reported pay period is longer than one week, the data are reduced to a week using the number of days the firm usually operates during a week divided by the number of working days covered by the reported pay period. If, owing to strikes, holidays or other similar factors, the data for the reported pay period are not representative of the reference period, adjustments are made to accurately reflect the situation of the last seven days of the month.

Employee. All persons drawing pay for services rendered or for paid absence during the survey reference period and for whom an employer makes CPP or QPP and/or UIC contributions constitute employees.

The employee concept comprises full-time employees, part-time employees (those who regularly work fewer hours than the standard work week of the firm), and casual employees (those who are hired for discontinuous periods or on an irregular basis and who have worked at least seven hours during the reference period).

The employee concept excludes owners or partners of unincorporated businesses and professional practices, the self-employed, unpaid family workers, persons doing non-remunerative work, pensioners, home workers, members of elected or appointed bodies, military personnel and persons providing services to an establishment on a contract basis. An employee working for a part of the reference period and unemployed or on strike for the rest is counted as employed. Persons not receiving pay for the entire reference period are excluded.

Paid absence. Paid absence comprises paid holidays, vacation, sick leave including industrial injury and personal leave such as bereavement leave, jury duty, etc.

Définitions

Période de référence. En théorie, les données sur l'emploi se rapportent aux sept derniers jours du mois de référence. En pratique, étant donné que peu d'entreprises tiennent des registres de paye pour cette période précise, on leur permet de faire porter leur déclaration sur la (les) dernière(s) période(s) de paye de chaque mois. Lorsque la période de paye sur laquelle porte la déclaration dépasse une semaine, on rajuste les données en effectuant le calcul suivant: on divise le nombre de jours d'activité hebdomadaire de l'entreprise par le nombre de jours ouvrables compris dans la période de paye sur laquelle porte la déclaration. Si, en raison d'une grève, d'un jour férié ou d'autres facteurs semblables, les données déclarées ne sont pas représentatives de la période de référence, on procède aux rajustements qui s'imposent afin de traduire fidèlement la situation pendant les sept derniers jours du mois.

Salarié. Toute personne qui est rétribuée pour ses services ou ses absences pendant la semaine de référence et pour laquelle l'employeur verse des contributions au RPC ou au RRQ et à la caisse d'assurance-chômage.

La catégorie "salariés" comprend les salariés à temps plein, les salariés à temps partiel (ceux qui travaillent régulièrement un nombre d'heures inférieur à la semaine normale de travail de l'entreprise) et les salariés occasionnels (ceux qui sont embauchés de façon temporaire ou irrégulière et qui ont travaillé au moins sept heures au cours de la période de référence).

Le concept des salariés exclut les propriétaires et les partenaires d'entreprises non constituées en corporation et ceux qui possèdent un bureau pour l'exercice d'une profession, les travailleurs autonomes, les travailleurs familiaux non rémunérés, les bénévoles, les retraités, les travailleurs à domicile, les membres de corps élus ou nommés, le personnel militaire et les personnes fournissant des services à un établissement sur une base forfaitaire. Sont visées les personnes qui ont travaillé pendant une partie de la période de référence mais qui étaient en chômage ou en grève pendant le reste de la période. Les personnes n'ayant pas touché de paye pour la période de référence entière ne sont pas visées.

Absence payée. Les absences payées comprennent les jours fériés payés, les vacances, les congés de maladie, y compris les congés d'accident du travail et les congés personnels tels que les congés de deuil et les congés pour fonctions de jury, etc.

Standard work week. The standard work week is the number of hours or days of work normally scheduled for the majority of full-time employees.

Firm. The firm is defined as any business entity whether incorporated or not; it comprises sole proprietorships, partnerships, corporations and other forms of organization such as co-operatives. Most firms consist of only one "establishment" (see definition under Industrial Classification) but in some cases the firm is made up of a number of establishments which may or may not be engaged in the same kind of economic activity.

Methodology

Employment, payrolls and manhours survey. This is a monthly mail census of firms employing 20 or more employees. Details regarding coverage, method of data collection, follow-up and imputation procedures for non-respondents may be found in Employment, Earnings and Hours, Catalogue 72-002.

Employment sample survey. Estimates of the total number of employees in firms employing fewer than 20 persons are obtained by means of a monthly mail sample survey. This survey was redesigned in January 1975 as follows:

Sample selection. The firms in the universe are divided among 16 geographical strata (the metropolitan areas of Montréal, Toronto, Winnipeg and Vancouver, the provinces and the territories) and 17 industry groups. Thus, the universe is stratified into 272 strata based on location and industry. Within each stratum, firms are assigned at random to a given number of clusters or panels in such a way that all panels are of equal size. For any given survey occasion, 12 of these panels are in the sample. Once a panel is selected it stays in the sample for 12 months. In order to reduce the burden imposed in the respondents, on each survey occasion one panel is taken out of the sample and is replaced by a new panel. There are exceptions to this rotation technique. Some strata are considered too small for rotation and the 12 panels selected initially are always in the sample. In some large strata, only a sample of the firms is assigned to the panels.

Data processing. Data from the firms in the sample are collected by mailed questionnaires. All the completed questionnaires which reach Statistics Canada are

Semaine normale de travail. La semaine normale de travail est le nombre d'heures ou de jours de travail normalement prévu pour la majorité des salariés à temps plein.

Entreprise. Le terme "entreprise" désigne toute entité commerciale constituée ou non en corporation; il peut s'agir d'une entreprise à propriétaire unique, d'une société en nom collectif, d'une corporation ou d'une autre forme d'organisation comme une coopérative. Méthodologie

Enquête-échantillon sur l'emploi. Cette enquête postale mensuelle permet d'obtenir les estimations du nombre total de salariés dans les entreprises employant moins de 20 personnes. Elle a été remaniée en janvier 1975:

Choix de l'échantillon. Les entreprises de l'univers sont réparties en 16 strates géographiques (les régions métropolitaines de Montréal, Toronto, Winnipeg et Vancouver, les provinces et les territoires) et en 17 groupes d'activité économique. Ainsi, l'univers est divisé en 272 strates en fonction du lieu géographique et de l'activité économique. À l'intérieur de chaque strate, les entreprises sont attribuées au hasard à un nombre donné de grappes ou panels de façon à ce que tous les panels soient de taille égale. Pour chaque enquête, 12 de ces panels sont inclus dans l'échantillon. Les panels choisis demeurent dans l'échantillon pendant 12 mois. Afin de réduire le fardeau de déclaration des entreprises enquêtées, on retire un panel de l'échantillon à chaque enquête et on le remplace par un autre. carefully edited for completeness, consistency and accuracy both manually and using computer edit procedures.

Non-respondents to the initial mailing are followed up by two mail reminders. Firms which are in the sample for the first time and which have not responded even after two reminders are followed up by the regional offices.

Employment figures for non-respondent firms in a stratum for which no previous data are available are imputed using means based on responses of firms in that stratum. In the case of firms for which data for the previous month are available, a ratio of the employment change based on a summation of the employment figures of the firms that responded both in the current and preceding month is applied to the previous month's data of each non-respondent in order to arrive at an estimate for the current month.

Estimation procedure. An estimate of the total number of employees in the h^{th} stratum is given by

$$Y_h = \frac{B_h M_h}{12} \sum_{i=1}^{12} Y_{hi}$$

where Y_{hi} is the total number of employees in the i^{th} selected panel in the h^{th} stratum. B_h is the weight that is used because only a sample of the firms is assigned to the panels. $B_h = 1$, if all the firms are assigned to the panels in the h^{th} stratum. M_h represents the total number of panels in the h^{th} stratum. An estimate of the overall total is obtained by adding stratum totals.

Other employment surveys. Employment data for Health, Welfare and Education are obtained by means of a monthly mailed census survey. Employment data for religious organizations are collected by means of an annual census survey. All completed questionnaires are edited manually. Data for non-respondents are imputed using previously reported data and other related information.

Public administration and defence. See Technical Notes, Statistics Canada, Catalogues 72-004, 72-007 and 72-009.

Other employment data. See "Notes", Statistics Canada, The Labour Force, Catalogue 71-001.

Reliability of the Estimates

Errors which are not related to sampling may occur in a survey operation due to many reasons; these are called **non-sampling errors**. Inability to obtain information from all units in the sample (non-response error), differences in the interpretation of questionnaires, incorrect information from respondents, mistakes in recording, coding and processing of data are examples of non-sampling errors. It should be noted that non-sampling errors also occur in complete censuses. In the sample and census surveys conducted to obtain data given in this publication, efforts have been made to reduce non-sampling errors by careful design of questionnaires, follow-up of non-respondents, editing of data and thorough control of processing operations.

Sampling errors occur because estimates are derived from a sample rather than from the entire universe. Estimates are subject to sampling errors in this report in two components only - the employment sample survey of firms with fewer than 20 employees and the household sample survey for fishing, trapping and private household services. The other sources of data are censuses and, thus, not subject to sampling errors.

If employment data were obtained from all firms employing less than 20 persons instead of a sample, different results would have been obtained even if the same questionnaires, instructions and processing techniques were used. This difference is called the sampling error of the estimate. The size of the error of the estimate. The size of the error is unknown, but it can be estimated from the sample itself by using a measure called relative standard error of a survey estimate. Thus, the standard error of a survey estimate is primarily a statistical measure of its sampling error; the relative standard error of an estimate is its standard error expressed as a per cent of the estimate.

Alphabetic symbols of the relative standard errors are used in this publication to give an indication of the reliability of the estimates and are based on a 12-month average of the relative standard errors of the estimates in the previous calendar year. The ranges of these indicators of sampling variability are:

Fiabilité des estimations

Des erreurs non attribuables à l'échantillonnage peuvent se glisser dans une enquête pour bien des raisons; on les appelle des **erreurs d'observation**. Impossibilité d'obtenir des renseignements de toutes les unités échantillonées (erreur de non-réponse), différences d'interprétation du questionnaire, renseignements incorrectes obtenus des unités répondantes, erreurs d'inscription, de codage et de traitement sont tous des exemples d'erreurs d'observation. Il convient de signaler qu'il se produit également des erreurs d'observation dans les enquêtes exhaustives. Dans les enquêtes-échantillon et les enquêtes exhaustives menées pour recueillir les données présentées dans cette publication, on s'est efforcé de réduire les erreurs d'observation par une conception soignée des questionnaires, la relance des entreprises non répondantes, la vérification des données et un contrôle rigoureux des opérations de traitement.

Les erreurs d'échantillonnage se produisent parce que les estimations sont établies à partir d'un échantillon plutôt que d'un univers entier. Les erreurs d'échantillon que renferme la présente publication sont attribuables à l'enquête-échantillon sur l'emploi et aux séries (pêche, piégeage et ménages privés) tirées de l'enquête-échantillon sur la population active. Les autres sources de données ne contribuent pas aux erreurs d'échantillonnage car il s'agit d'enquêtes exhaustives.

Si l'on obtenait les données sur l'emploi de toutes les entreprises employant moins de 20 personnes au lieu d'un échantillon, nous obtiendrions des résultats différents même si les mêmes questionnaires, instructions et techniques de traitement étaient utilisés. On appelle cette différence "l'erreur d'échantillonnage de l'estimation". On n'en connaît pas l'importance, mais on peut l'évaluer à partir de l'échantillon lui-même en utilisant une mesure appelée "erreur type relative d'une estimation d'enquête". Ainsi, l'erreur type d'une estimation d'enquête est avant tout une mesure statistique de son erreur d'échantillonnage; l'erreur type relative d'une estimation est son erreur type exprimée en pourcentage de l'estimation.

Des symboles littéraux de l'erreur type relative sont utilisés dans ce bulletin comme indicateurs de la fiabilité des estimations et sont fondés sur une moyenne de 12 mois des erreurs types exprimées en pourcentage pour l'année civile précédente. Voici l'échelle de ces indicateurs de la variabilité d'échantillonnage:

The sample estimate and its relative standard error may be used to construct a range within which the unknown census value is expected to lie with a specified confidence. Text Table I gives the alphabetic symbols of relative standard errors for the estimates of the total number of paid employees by industry and province. For example, let the estimate under consideration be the total number of paid employees at Canada level in manufacturing. From the table it is seen that this estimate has a reliability indicator A. If the estimate itself is 1,850,000 employees then taking the relative standard error as 0.5%, the census value of the total number of paid employees is expected to be between 1,831,000 and 1,868,000 with 95% confidence.

L'estimation de l'échantillon et son erreur type relative peuvent être utilisées pour construire un intervalle à l'intérieur duquel on peut s'attendre, à un seuil de confiance donné, que se situe la valeur réelle. Le tableau explicatif I qui suit présente les symboles littéraux des erreurs types relatives pour les estimations du nombre total de salariés par activité économique et par province. Par exemple, supposons que l'estimation à l'étude est le nombre total de salariés dans les industries manufacturières à l'échelle du Canada. En examinant le tableau, on constate que cette estimation affiche un indicateur de fiabilité A. Si l'estimation elle-même est 1,850,000 salariés, l'erreur type relative étant 0.5%, on s'attend à ce que la valeur réelle du nombre total de salariés se situe entre 1,831,000 et 1,868,000 à un seuil de confiance de 95%.

Statistical Presentation

Seasonal Adjustment

Fluctuations in economic time series are caused by seasonal, cyclical and irregular movements. A seasonally adjusted series is one from which seasonal movements have been eliminated. Seasonal movements are defined as those which are caused by regular annual events such as climate, crop cycles, holidays and vacation periods. It should be noted that the seasonally adjusted series contains irregular as well as long-term cyclical fluctuations.

The X-11 variant of the U.S. Bureau of the Census Method II is used to seasonally adjust the data. This seasonal adjustment system is a complex computer program which differentiates between the seasonal trend and the irregular movements in a series over a number of years and, on the basis of past movements, estimates appropriate seasonal factors for current data. On an annual basis the entire historic series of seasonally

Présentation statistique

Désaisonnalisation

Les fluctuations des séries chronologiques économiques sont causées par des mouvements saisonniers, cycliques et irréguliers. Une série désaisonnalisée est une série dont on a éliminé les effets des mouvements saisonniers. Les mouvements saisonniers sont ceux qui sont causés par des événements annuels réguliers comme les changements de température, les cycles agricoles et les vacances. Il convient de noter que la série désaisonnalisée contient des fluctuations irrégulières ainsi que des fluctuations cycliques à long terme.

La variante X-11 de la Method II de désaisonnalisation du U.S. Bureau of the Census est utilisée pour désaisonnaliser. Ce système de désaisonnalisation est un programme informatique complexe qui permet de déceler les mouvements saisonniers, tendanciels et irréguliers au cours d'une période de plusieurs années et, à la lumière des mouvements passés, d'estimer les coefficients saisonniers appropriés pour l'année en cours. Sur une base annuelle, toute la série

adjusted data is revised in light of the most recent information on changes in seasonality.

This system is used to calculate the seasonally adjusted estimates of the number of employees.

Confidentiality

The information presented in this publication has been reviewed to ensure that the confidentiality of individual responses is respected.

Data Revision

Each month, statistics for three months are prepared. Data for the first, most current, month are entitled **first estimates**. They are based on a limited number of returns (usually about 50%) and only highly aggregated figures are released in the **Statistics Canada Daily** and in Table 1 of this publication. Simultaneously second estimates (known as **preliminary data**) are prepared for the month immediately preceding the most current data and third estimates (shown as **revised data**) for the month prior to that. Both of these latter estimates are of higher quality than that of the first because of the higher rate of returns (typically, 65% and 75% respectively). Consequently full details for both months are shown within this publication.

Révision des données

Chaque mois, des statistiques sont préparées pour trois mois. Les données du premier mois, le mois le plus récent, sont appelées **premières estimations**. Elles sont fondées sur un nombre limité de déclarations (environ 50%) et seuls des chiffres très généraux sont publiés dans le **Quotidien de Statistique Canada** et dans le tableau 1 de la présente publication. En même temps, des deuxièmes estimations (présentées comme **chiffres préliminaires**) sont préparées pour le mois qui précède le mois le plus récent de même que des troisièmes estimations (**chiffres révisés**) pour le mois qui précède celui-là. Ces deux dernières estimations sont de meilleure qualité que les premières en raison de la disponibilité d'un plus grand nombre de réponses (d'habitude 65% pour les deuxièmes estimations et 75% pour les troisièmes). Par conséquent, la présente publication contient tous les détails pour ces deux mois.


