# FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT IN METROPOLITAN AREAS

SEPTEMBER 1968

## INTRODUCTION

This publication presents statistics on employment and payrolls, respecting Government of Canada employees in metropolitan areas, as of September 1968. Terms used in this publication are defined in the Glossary in Appendix B, page 22.

### Composition of the Metropolitan Areas

The nineteen metropolitan areas covered by this publication are those so defined for the purposes of the 1961 Census of Population. A list of the metropolitan areas and their components is provided in Appendix A, page 20. It will be noted in respect to the metropolitan area of Regina, Saskatoon and Calgary, that the boundaries are coincident with those of the cities themselves.

### Extent of Coverage

The publication contains statistics relating to employees of departments and departmental corporations (as designated in Schedules A and B respectively of the Financial Administration Act). Excluded, therefore, are statistics with respect to employees of agency corporations, proprietary corporations, and other agencies and corporations. Organizational units included as departmental corporations are:

Judges  
The Prime Minister, Speakers of the Senate and the House of Commons, Deputy Speakers of the House of Commons, Ministers of the Crown and Parliamentary Secretaries, and  
Members of boards and commissions who are paid on a per diem basis or who receive a nominal honorarium for their services.

The payroll data pertains to regular payrolls only and consequently excludes overtime or retro-active salary increase payments.

### Comparability Between Number of Employees and Regular Payrolls

Users are cautioned against attempting to derive average salary rates by making direct comparison between the number of employees and the payroll, as data relating to each are reported on different and therefore non-comparable bases.

### Analysis of Data

Federal government employees, in departments and departmental corporations, numbered 234.4 thousand at the end of September 1968. This publication provides an analysis of the data relating to the 166.6 thousand or 71.0 per cent that were employed in metropolitan areas.

The number of employees in the metropolitan areas increased by 9.7 thousand or 6.2 per cent over the total employed at the end of September 1967. The main contributing factor for the increase, in the number of employees, was the transfer of a number of employees in semi-staff post offices to full operational status.

Metropolitan areas with the greater number of employees were: Ottawa-Hull, 57.5 thousand (24.5 per cent); Montreal 26.3 thousand (11.2 per cent); Toronto, 19.4 thousand (8.3 per cent); Vancouver, 11.3 thousand (4.8 per cent); and Halifax, 9.7 thousand (4.2 per cent). Comparable figures for September 1967 are: Ottawa-Hull, 56.3 thousand (23.8 per cent); Montreal 21.7 thousand (9.2 per cent); Toronto, 17.1 thousand (7.3 per cent); Vancouver, 10.0 thousand (4.2 per cent); and Halifax 10.0 thousand (4.2 per cent).

There was a slight increase in the number of female employees during the year. In the Ottawa-Hull area, where there was the highest female ratio, 37 out of every hundred employees were females, this compares with 36 out of every hundred at September 30, 1967. Halifax, with two females out of every hundred, had the lowest ratio.

Of the total federal employees, 74 per cent of salaried; 73 per cent of ships' officers and crews; 52 per cent of prevailing rate; and, 58 per cent of casuals were employed in the metropolitan areas. Twenty-six per cent of all salaried employees were in the Ottawa-Hull area.

Of the twenty-six departments and thirteen departmental corporations, included in this report, there were three departments and three departmental

corporations whose personnel were entirely employed in the Ottawa-Hull area. These are listed below:

Following is a commentary on the most significant changes which occurred during the year:

**Finance, Department of**

The statistics indicate a decrease of 81 per cent in the number of employees of this department. This decrease resulted from the transfer of the functions and staff of the Office of the Comptroller of the Treasury to the Department of Supply and Services and various other departments.

**Post Office**

The number of employees increased by 9,758 or 36 per cent as a result of the transfer of a number of employees from semi-staff post offices to full operational status.

**Secretary of State, Department of**

The number of employees in this department increased to 3,758 at the end of September 1968 from 1,002 at the end of September 1967. This was primarily due to the inclusion, under this department, of several branches formerly shown separately. These are:

**Solicitor General, Department of the**

Statistics with respect to the Correctional Services indicate a considerable decrease from the previous years total, due mainly to the exclusion of the guards at the federal penitentiaries. These guards, up to and including the period under review, were not subject to the provisions of the Civil Service Act and should not have been included in the previous publications.

**Supply and Services, Department of**

This department was established to assume the functions of the former Department of Defence Production and some of the responsibilities of the Office of the Comptroller of the Treasury.

**Historical Analysis**

This publication was initially produced in this form, as of March 31, 1961, and as of September 30 thereafter. The period from March 31, 1961 to September 30, 1968 has seen an increase in total federal government employees of 32,992 or 16 per cent. Those employed in Metropolitan areas, during the period, increased by 35,959 or 27.5 per cent, while total annual payrolls in metropolitan areas increased by 87 per cent.

Employment changes in particular metropolitan areas during the period March 31, 1961 to September 30, 1968, have varied. The greatest change occurred in the Montreal area where there was an increase of 8,875 employees or 50.8 per cent. The number of federal government employees in the Toronto area increased by 4,316 or 28.5 per cent. There were 2,758 more employees in the Vancouver area at the end of the period, than at the beginning. This represented an increase of 32.3 per cent. The Ottawa-Hull area, in which there is the greatest concentration of federal government employees, reflected an increase of 11,395 or 24.7 per cent during the period.

## APPENDIX B. Glossary of Principal Terms Used

1. **Metropolitan Areas:** These are essentially the same as those developed by the Census Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. They include the suburban fringe or thickly settled territory lying outside of, but adjacent to, the boundaries of the larger cities in Canada.
2. **Salaried employee:** An employee who is paid on the basis of an annual salary rate and occupies a salaried position authorized by the Treasury Board or the Privy Council. These employees and positions may be of a continuing, term, seasonal, sessional, or part-time nature. The positions are specified together with appropriate funds, in the Estimates of Canada and supplementary authorizing documents and are located in departmental branches, services and corporations subject to the regulation of the Treasury Board. Ships' officers are not classified as salaried owing to their special treatment under the Financial Administration Act.
3. **Pervailing rate employee:** A person employed in the Public Service of Canada whose remuneration is based on the rate of pay prevailing in the area where he is employed for the class of work he performs. His rate of pay may also be based on rates prevailing in any area in Canada for work comparable to that which he performs. The rates may be hourly, daily, weekly or monthly. These employees, previously governed by the Financial Administration Act are, as of February, 1967, included under the Public Service Employment Act. They are occupants of positions authorized by the Treasury Board, which, together with appropriate funds, are listed in the Estimates of Canada and supplementary authorizing documents.
4. **Ships' officer:** A person employed in the Public Service for duty on a ship that is the property of, or chartered by, or on behalf of Her Majesty as a master, mate or marine engineer who is duly certified under the Canadian Shipping Act or in a position designated by the Treasury Board as that of a ship's officer. Excluded are members of the Armed Forces and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. An annual rate of pay is determined by the Treasury Board after consultation with the Department of Labour. These employees are governed by the Financial Administration Act—Ships' Officer's Regulations. They are occupants of positions established by the Treasury Board, which, together with appropriate funds, are listed in the Estimates of Canada and supplementary authorizing documents.
5. **Ships' crew employee:** A person employed in the Public Service for duty on a ship that is the property of, or chartered by, or on behalf of Her Majesty as an unlicensed crew member. Excluded are members of the Armed Forces and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. These employees are paid on the basis of a monthly salary rate determined by the Treasury Board after consultation with the Department of Labour. They are governed by the Financial Administration Act—Ships' Crews Regulations. These employees are occupants of positions established by the Treasury Board, which, together with appropriate funds, are listed in the Estimates of Canada and supplementary authorizing documents.
6. **Casual employees:** An employee engaged on a casual basis, or for a period not exceeding 12 months. These personnel may perform the duties which would normally be carried out by salaried, prevailing rate or ships' crew employees. They may be paid out of either the Salaries and Wages Object or other financial objects of expenditure. For example, persons employed and paid out of monies provided for the repair and upkeep of furniture would be considered casual employees, unless engaged on a contractual basis.
7. **Regular payroll:** The basic wage and salary payments to employees during a specified period of time, excluding overtime, retroactive and other payments, but before deductions for income tax, etc. Includes payroll for all those employed during the month whether they were on strength at the end of the month or not. If there were semi-monthly, fortnightly or weekly payments in a month, the total amount paid for the month constitutes the "Regular payroll".

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
