

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

Introduction

This publication presents statistics on employment and payrolls, respecting Government of Canada employees in metropolitan areas, as of September 1970. The latest available preceding issue in this series related to data for September 1968. Data as of September 1969 were not available for publication.

Earlier issues in this series provided employment and payroll data under the categories "salaried", "prevailing rate", "ships' officers and crews" and "casuals and others". Effective April 1, 1969 a system of identifying employees by occupational category was adapted by the federal government. This publication is the first in this series to present data within these occupational categories.

Terms used in this publication are defined in the glossary in Appendix B, page 33.

Composition of the Metropolitan Areas

The nineteen metropolitan areas covered by this publication are those so defined for purposes of the 1961 Census of Population. A list of the metropolitan areas and their components is provided in Appendix A, page 30. It will be noted in respect of the metropolitan areas of Regina, Saskatoon and Calgary, that the boundaries are coincident with those of the cities themselves.

Extent of Coverage

This publication contains statistics relating to employees of departments and departmental corporations (as designated in Schedules A and B respectively of the Financial Administration Act). Excluded therefore, are statistics with respect to employees of agency corporations, proprietary corporations and other agencies and corporations. Included are both the civilian and uniformed personnel of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. Excluded in addition to employees of agency corporations, proprietary corporations and other agencies and corporations are:

Employees of Revenue Post Offices

Governor General and Lieutenant-Governor

Judges

The Prime Minister, Speakers of the Senate and House of Commons, Deputy Speaker of the House of the Crown, Parliamentary Secretaries, Members of Parliament and Senators.

Members of boards and commissions who are paid on a per diem basis or who receive a nominal honorarium for their services.

The payroll data pertains to regular payrolls only and consequently excludes overtime and retro-active salary increase payments.

Comparability Between Number of Employees and Regular Payroll

Users are cautioned against attempting to derive average salary rates by making direct comparison between the number of employees and the payroll, as data relating to each are reported on different and therefore non-comparable bases.

Analysis of Data

Federal government employees, in departments and departmental corporations, numbered 237 thousand at the end of September 1970. This publication provides an analysis of the 155.5 thousand or 65.6 percent that were employed in metropolitan areas. Data for September 1969 being unavailable it is not possible to provide comparable information.

Metropolitan areas with the greater number of employees were: Ottawa-Hull, 57.6 thousand (24.3 per cent); Montreal, 21.4 thousand (9.0 per cent); Toronto, 16.6 thousand (7.0 per cent); Vancouver, 10.0 thousand (4.2 per cent); and Halifax, 9.6 thousand (4.1 per cent).

Female employees numbered 48 thousand with the Ottawa-Hull area having the highest ratio with 38 out of every hundred employees being female. Quebec, with 2 females out of every hundred employees, had the lowest ratio.

Of the twenty-six departments and eleven departmental corporations, included in this report, there were two departments and four departmental corporations whose personnel were entirely employed in the Ottawa-Hull area. These are listed below:

Statistics Canada being precluded from publishing data which might permit the identification of individuals, it has been necessary to omit data concerning 339 employees with a payroll of \$58 thousand from the main body of Tables 5 and 6 and include these data in the grand totals only.

Historical Analysis

This publication was initially in this form as of March 31, 1961 and as of September 30 thereafter. The period from March 31, 1961 to September 30, 1970, has seen an increase in total federal government employees of 35,755 or 17.8 per cent. Those employed in metropolitan areas, during the period, increased by 24,911 or 19.1 per cent, while the total annual payrolls, in metropolitan areas, increased by 97.3 per cent.

Employment changes in particular metropolitan areas during the period March 31, 1961 to September 30, 1970, have varied. The Ottawa-Hull area, in which there is the greatest concentration of federal government employees, recorded the greatest change with an increase of 11,496 or 24.9 per cent. Following the Ottawa-Hull area in order of the greatest change were: Montreal with 3,899 more employees or a 22.2 per cent increase; Vancouver, 1,481 or a 17.3 per cent increase, and, Toronto, 1,511 or a 9.9 per cent increase.



APPENDIX B. Glossary of Principal Terms Used


1. Metropolitan Areas those are essentially the same as those developed by the Census Division of Statistics Canada. They include the suburban fringe or thickly settled territory lying outside of, but adjacent to, the boundaries of the larger cities in Canada.
2. Executive Category is composed of occupational groups engaged in the development of government policy, the direction of government programmes and related functions in which there is a requirement for exceptional ability in utilizing resources or in initiating or modifying administrative functions.
3. Scientific and Professional Category is composed of occupational groups engaged in the application of a comprehensive body of knowledge acquired through university graduation in fields specified in group definitions, and of professional groups in which membership in Canada is generally controlled by legally established licensing bodies. Some fields included within this occupational category are; auditing, biological sciences, dentistry, economics, sociology and statistics, engineering and land survey.
4. Administrative and Foreign Service Category is composed of occupational groups engaged in the planning, execution, conduct and control of programmes serving the public interest, the political and economic relations between Canada and other countries, and the requirements of internal management in the Public Service of Canada.
5. Technical Category is composed of occupational groups engaged in the conduct of analytical, experimental and investigative duties in the natural, physical, and social sciences, and the preparation, inspection and measurement of biological, chemical, and physical substances and materials, and the design, construction, inspection, operation and maintenance of complex equipment, systems and process, and the performance of similar technical duties.
6. Administrative Support Category is composed of occupational groups engaged in the preparation, transcribing, transmitting, systematizing and maintenance of records, reports and communications of manual processes, or by operating various machines and equipment, as in the direct application of rules and regulations.
7. Operational Category is composed of occupational groups engaged in the performance of a craft or of unskilled work in the fabrication, maintenance and repair activities, in the operation of machines, equipment and vehicles, and in the provision of postal, protective, correctional, personal or domestic services.
8. Casual and Others Category is composed of all employees in Departments and Departmental corporations of the Government of Canada who are not defined as in Executive, Scientific and Professional, Administrative and Foreign Service, Technical, Administrative Support or Operational categories.
9. Regular Payroll the basic wage and salary payments made to employees during a specified period of time, excluding overtime, retroactive salary payments and special payments.



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
