AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$396 MILLION IN 2015


IDAHO EXPORTED \$173 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$36M in processed potatoes (incl. fries and chips)
- \$32M in vegetables (incl. \$17M in beans and peas)
- \$24M in canola seeds
- \$19M in peptone proteins
- \$9M in whey protein

IDAHO IMPORTED \$223 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:


- \$83M in animal feed (incl. \$64M in canola meal)
- \$26M in refined canola oil
- \$23M in seeds used for sowing (incl. \$20M in alfalfa seeds)
- \$21M in fresh/frozen beef
- \$14M in dried distillery grains

IDAHO'S TOP AGRICULTURE AND AGRI-FOOD EXPORT MARKETS:



A STRONG PARTNERSHIP IN TRADE:

- Canada is the top destination for U.S. exports of agricultural products.
- Supply chains that cross our shared border are cost-effective and efficient because of the proximity to each other's agricultural inputs and products.
- Canada is a major destination for value-added U.S. agriculture products, which helps sustain American trade jobs.
- Canada purchased over \$25B in agriculture and agri-food products from the U.S. in 2015, of which \$173M came from Idaho, showcasing our strong partnership in trade.
