**AGRICULTURAL TRADE =  
\$237 MILLION IN 2015**

**MAINE EXPORTED \$89 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$26M in prepared chicken meat
- \$12M in berries
- \$13M in processed potatoes (incl. fries)
- \$7M in maple syrup
- \$6M in live animals

**MAINE IMPORTED \$148 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$31M in animal feed
- \$30M in fruits and nuts (incl. \$17M in berries)
- \$18M in live plants
- \$12M in margarine
- \$11M in baked goods

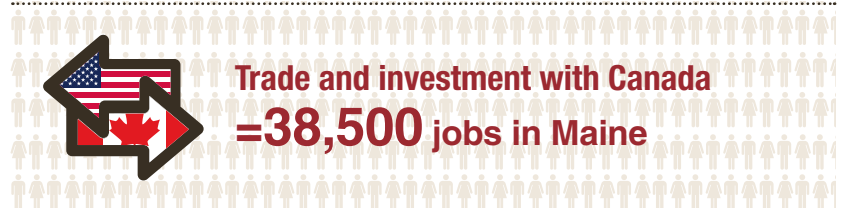

## A STRONG PARTNERSHIP IN TRADE:

- Canada is the top destination for U.S. exports of agricultural products.
- Supply chains that cross our shared border are cost-effective and efficient because of the proximity to each other's agricultural inputs and products.
- Canada is a major destination for value-added U.S. agriculture products, which helps sustain American trade jobs.
- Canada purchased over \$25B in agriculture and agri-food products from the U.S. in 2015, of which \$89M came from Maine, showcasing our strong partnership in trade.
