### AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$329 MILLION IN 2015

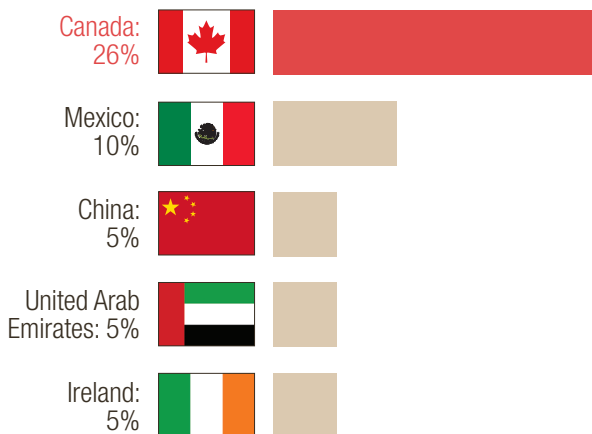
#### MARYLAND EXPORTED \$82 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$21M in pepper (incl. \$17M in ground pepper)
- \$8M in vegetables (incl. \$4M in lettuce)
- \$6M in baked goods
- \$4M in sauces and condiments
- \$4M in beverages

#### MARYLAND IMPORTED \$247 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

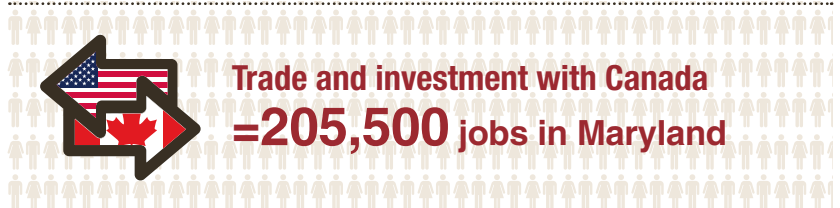
- \$41M in animal feed (incl. \$15M in soybean meal)
- \$39M in vegetables
- \$34M in baked goods
- \$22M in sauces and condiments
- \$21M in fresh/frozen meat (incl. \$9M in beef)

#### A STRONG PARTNERSHIP IN TRADE:

- Canada is the top destination for U.S. exports of agricultural products.
- Supply chains that cross our shared border are cost-effective and efficient because of the proximity to each other's agricultural inputs and products.
- Canada is a major destination for value-added U.S. agriculture products, which helps sustain American trade jobs.
- Canada purchased over \$25B in agriculture and agri-food products from the U.S. in 2015, of which \$82M came from Maryland, showcasing our strong partnership in trade.
