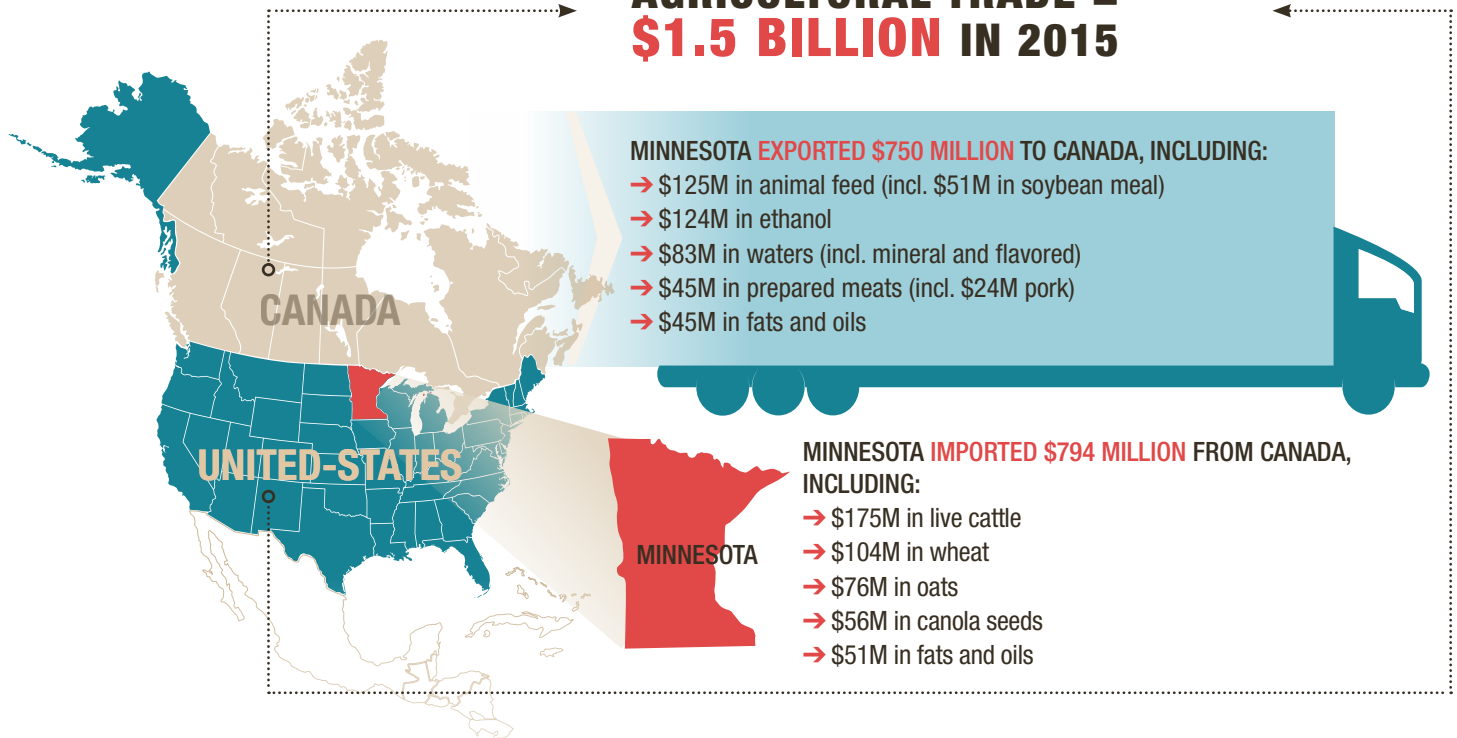


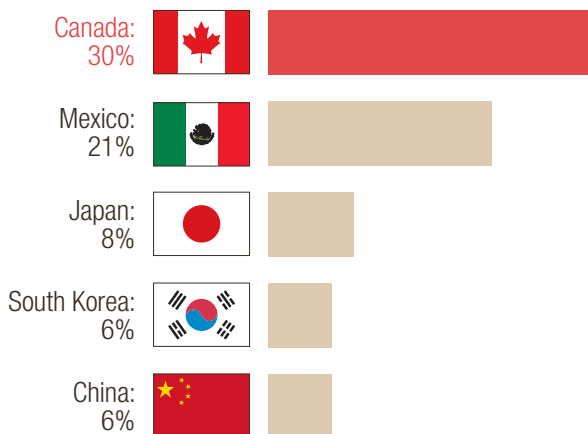

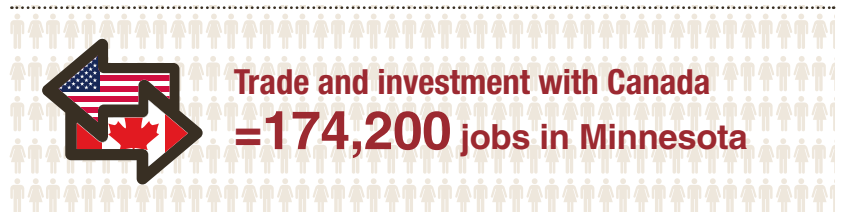


MINNESOTA'S TOP AGRICULTURE AND AGRI-FOOD EXPORT MARKETS:



A STRONG PARTNERSHIP IN TRADE:

Fueling bilateral trade! – According to the Minnesota Department of Commerce, Canada supplies approximately 80% of the crude oil used for transportation fuel products in Minnesota. Meanwhile, with 16 ethanol plants, Minnesota supplies Canada with ethanol (\$124M in 2015). Canada and Minnesota's fuel trade landscape exists against the backdrop of an integrated North American agricultural and energy market. Additionally, biomass is often traded to be processed into biofuels and other products for consumption in either the U.S. or Canada. This trade fuels jobs, economic development, the corn and soy industries and rural communities!
