

AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$117 MILLION IN 2015


MISSISSIPPI EXPORTED \$72 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$14M in fresh/frozen chicken meat
- → \$9M in prepared cereal grains (incl. breakfast cereal)
- → \$7M in sweet potatoes
- → \$4M in sauces and condiments

MISSISSIPPI IMPORTED \$45 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- → \$28M in prepared cereal grains (incl. breakfast cereal)
- → \$4M in baked goods
- → \$4M in alcoholic beverages
- → \$2M in chocolate products
- → \$1M in fats and oils

A STRONG PARTNERSHIP IN TRADE:

- Canada is the top destination for U.S. exports of agricultural products.
 - Supply chains that cross our shared border are cost-effective and efficient because of the proximity to each other's agricultural inputs and products.
 - Canada is a major destination for value-added U.S. agriculture products, which helps sustain American trade jobs.
- Canada purchased over \$25B in agriculture and agri-food products from the U.S. in 2015, of which \$72M came from Mississippi, showcasing our strong partnership in trade.
