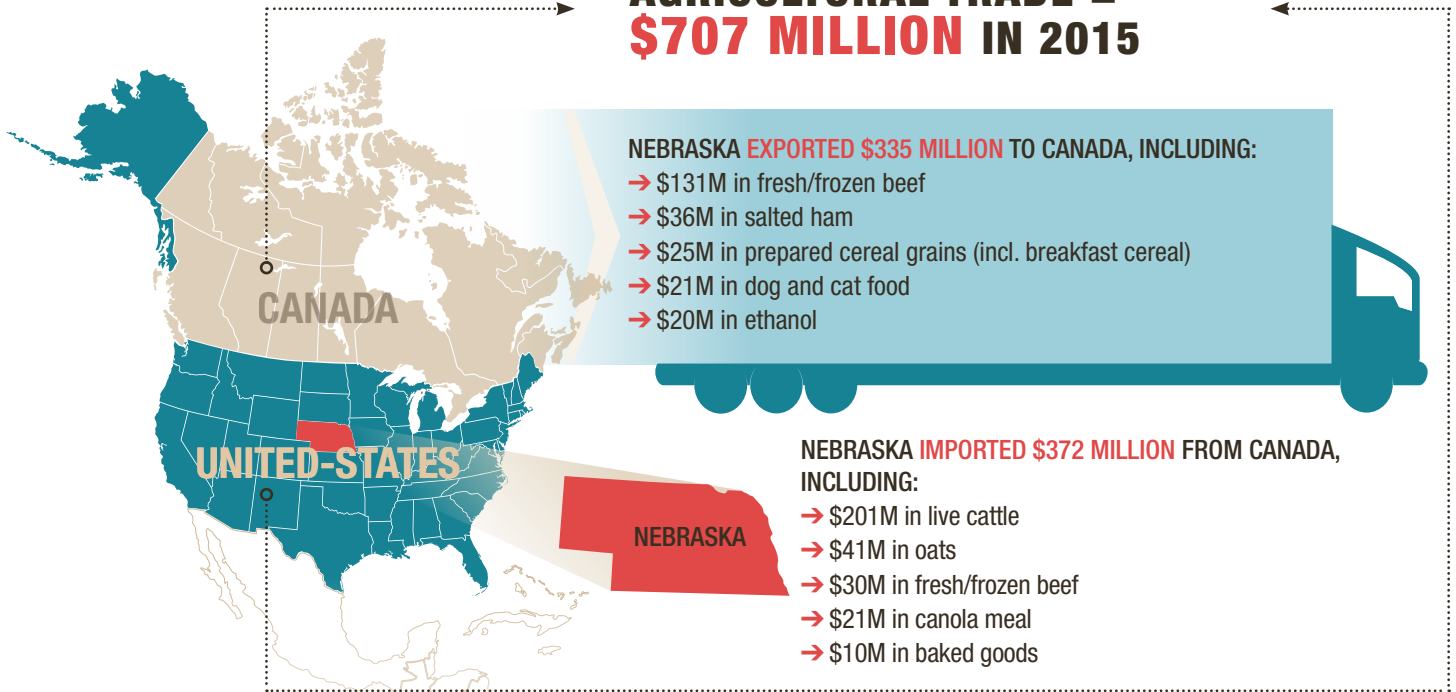


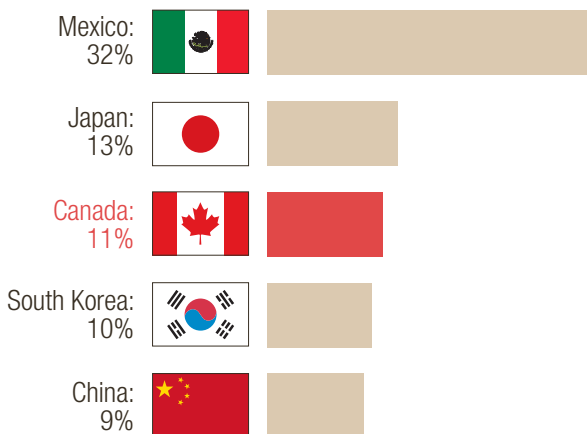

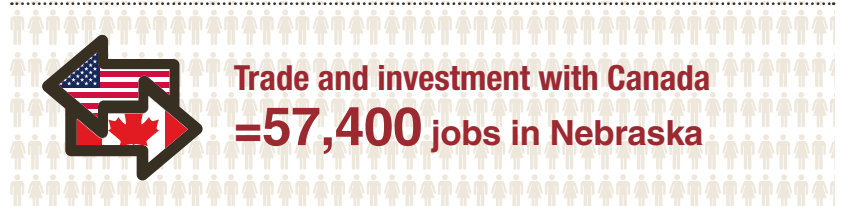


NEBRASKA'S TOP AGRICULTURE AND AGRI-FOOD EXPORT MARKETS:



A STRONG PARTNERSHIP IN TRADE:

Feeding an integrated supply chain! – Canadian cattle production supports an efficient supply-chain relationship with Nebraska, and Nebraska's top ranked cattle and beef industry is valued by Canadians for its animal processing efficiencies. In 2015, Canada exported \$201M in cattle to Nebraska. In the same year, Nebraska exported \$131M in beef to Canada. High-quality cattle from Canada help Nebraska's feedlots and processing plants operate at full capacity, while Nebraska's meat industry expertise provides options for processing Canadian livestock. It is therefore critical that agricultural policies do not run counter to these market efficiencies. Working together, the beef trade between Nebraska and Canada can thrive, supporting jobs and economies in rural communities.
