UTAH EXPORTED \$129 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

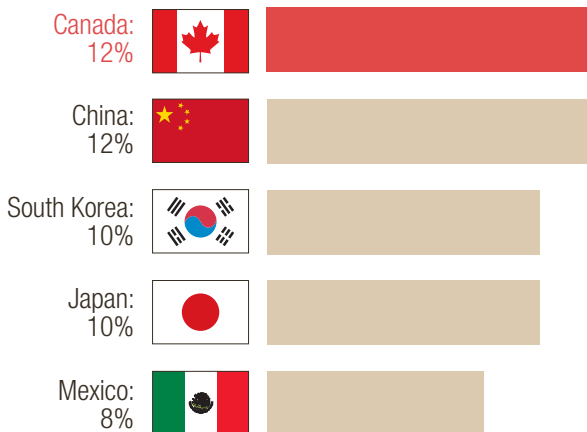
- \$46M in food preparations\*

UTAH IMPORTED \$374 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$153M in live cattle
- \$40M in chocolate products
- \$26M in food preparations\*
- \$22M in fresh/frozen pork
- \$19M in prepared beef

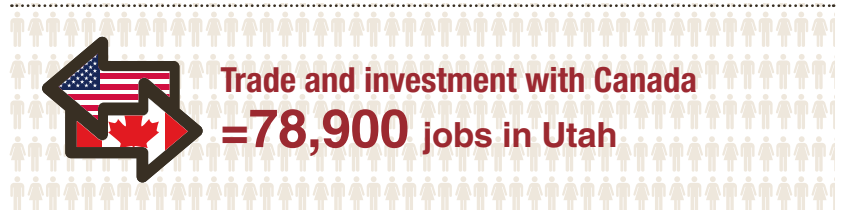
\* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.

- Canada is the top destination for U.S. exports of agricultural products.
- Supply chains that cross our shared border are cost-effective and efficient because of the proximity to each other's agricultural inputs and products.
- Canada is a major destination for value-added U.S. agriculture products, which helps sustain American trade jobs.
- Canada purchased over \$25B in agriculture and agri-food products from the U.S. in 2015, of which \$129M came from Utah, showcasing our strong partnership in trade.
