VERMONT EXPORTED \$120 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

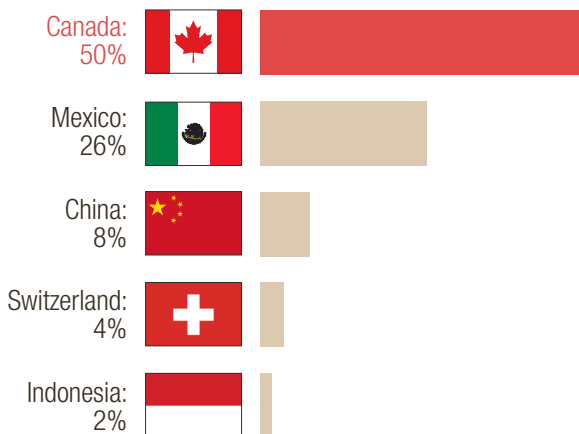
- \$39M in chocolate products

VERMONT IMPORTED \$463 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$212M in chocolate products
- \$62M in animal feed (incl. \$27M in canola meal)
- \$32M in maple syrup
- \$31M in food preparations*
- \$27M in corn

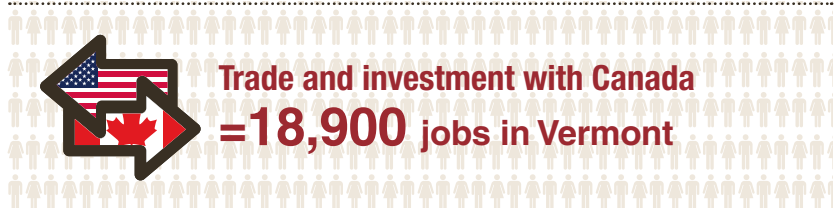
* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.

A STRONG PARTNERSHIP IN TRADE:

- Canada is the top destination for U.S. exports of agricultural products.
- Supply chains that cross our shared border are cost-effective and efficient because of the proximity to each other's agricultural inputs and products.
- Canada is a major destination for value-added U.S. agriculture products, which helps sustain American trade jobs.
- Canada purchased over \$25B in agriculture and agri-food products from the U.S. in 2015, of which \$120M came from Vermont, showcasing our strong partnership in trade.
