


A STRONG PARTNERSHIP IN AGRICULTURE

- Canada is the top destination for U.S. exports of agricultural products.
 - Supply chains that cross our shared border are cost-effective and efficient because of the proximity to each other's agricultural inputs and products.
 - Canada is a major destination for value-added U.S. agriculture products, which helps sustain American trade jobs.
- Canada purchased over \$25B in agriculture and agri-food products from the U.S. in 2015, of which \$61M came from Connecticut, showcasing our strong partnership in trade.
