FPCC August Meeting

The FPCC met on August 3, 2016, via conference call. Here is a summary of the decisions.

Council approved the following proposed Amendments: *Canadian Egg Marketing Agency Quota Regulations, 1986* (Schedule 1.1), *Canadian Egg Marketing Levies Order*, *Canadian Chicken Marketing Quota Regulations* (periods A-139 and A-140), *Canadian Turkey Marketing Quota Regulations, 1990* and *Beef Cattle Research Market Development and Promotion Levies Order*.

FPCC September Meeting

The FPCC met on September 14-15, 2016. Here is a summary of the decisions.

EFC's Quota Regulations (vaccine eggs)

Following a thorough review of the rationale provided by **Egg Farmers of Canada's** (EFC) to justify the level of production of vaccine eggs requested, Council members were satisfied that there were sufficient grounds and information to conclude that the amendment to the quota regulations meets the intention of the marketing plan and the objects of the Agency.



TFC' Quota Regulations

Turkey Farmers of Canada's (TFC) request to amend the *Canadian Turkey Marketing Quota Regulations, 1980* for the current 2016-2017 control period (May 1, 2016, to April 30, 2017), was considered by the Council at this meeting. Council members, being satisfied that this amendment was necessary for the marketing plan and that it met TFC's obligations under the *Farm Products Agencies Act*, approved the request.



CHEP's Quota and Levies Order

The Standing Joint Committee for the Scrutiny of Regulations (SJC) had requested that the **Canadian Hatching Egg Producers** (CHEP) amend their Marketing, Pricing and Licensing Regulations to comply with section 16 of the *Interpretation Act* which states that: *Where an enactment confers power to make regulations, expressions used in the regulations have the same respective meanings as in the enactment conferring the power.*



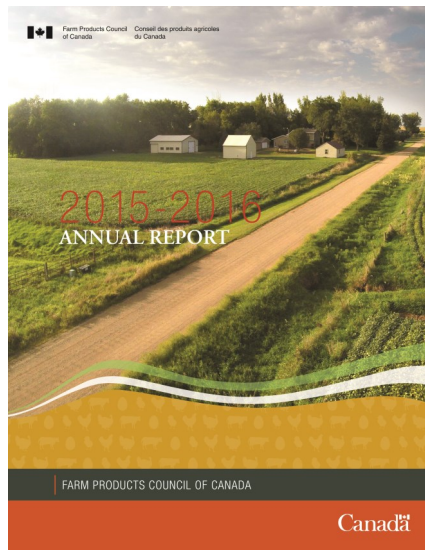
To comply with the SJC's request, from each of the fore-mentioned regulations, CHEP removed the section "Unless otherwise provided, the definitions in section 1 of the schedule to the *Canadian Hatching Egg Producers Proclamation* apply in these Regulations".

Also during this meeting, Council discussed FPCC's By-Laws, Governance Manual as well as the Governor-in-Council appointment process.
