

KEY INDUSTRIAL CAPABILITIES IN QUEBEC

LAND



In the context of the Industrial and Technological Benefits Policy, Canada Economic Development for Quebec Regions supports contractors in developing their value proposition. Analysis of the key industrial capabilities in Quebec is a core aspect of this exercise.

Key capabilities - Land

Quebec has significant expertise in **eight market segments** connected with the defence sector*:

1. Munitions.

2. Primarily land-based or man-portable electro-optical, radar, sonar and other sensor/ Information collection systems; fire control, warning and countermeasures systems, and related components.

3. Primarily land-based, man-portable or non-platform specific communications and navigation systems; and other information systems (including processing and dissemination), software, electronics and components.

4. Combat vehicles and components.

5. Combat vehicles maintenance, repair and overhaul and connected training activities.

6. Simulation systems for land vehicles and other applications, including personnel training through simulation exercises (e.g. intelligent software, visual systems, network simulations and real-time simulators).

7. Live personnel and combat training services, including ground military training; and training of military gunners and snipers.

8. Troop support, mainly military and protective clothing, as well as camp facilities and military shelters.

* The eight segments include sales connected with production and research services, development, design, engineering, testing and evaluation; with maintenance, repairs and review services, the sales connected with these services are included.
