The Trade Commission has reviewed and accepted the results of recently concluded bilateral consultations during which agreement was reached on a list of items that will be subject to earlier FTA tariff elimination. The agreement is subject to final approval by both governments.

# Under the agreement:

- More than 250 tariff items in each country's tariff schedule are covered. In addition, the agreement includes 400 specific products.
- There is a balance of trade interests. The package covers more than \$1.0 billion in Canadian exports to the U.S. and approximately the same value of U.S. exports to Canada, based on 1990 trade data.
- Canadian exporters will benefit from duty-free access to the U.S. market in a number of areas, including (figures represent projected exports for 1990):

- plastic-making moulds (\$209 million);

- styrene (\$200 million);

- fresh or chilled beef (\$141 million);

- canola seed, oil and oil cakes (\$138 million);

- flaxseed (\$73 million);

- coated abrasives (\$60 million); and

- water-purifying machinery (\$43 million).

- bilateral tariffs on railway passenger coaches and their parts will be eliminated immediately. The United States has also agreed to eliminate its tariffs on freight cars of Canadian origin. The current U.S. tariff on most Canadian railway cars is 12.6%.
- canadian manufacturers also will benefit from the elimination of Canadian duties on a range of products that are not made in Canada and are being imported from the United States for use in domestic manufacturing.
- In keeping with industry requests, tariffs on most items will be eliminated upon implementation of the agreement.
- The agreement is subject to a final approval process in Canada and the United States. In the United States, the process includes a review of the package by the House Ways and Means Committee and the Senate Finance Committee. The Committees have 60 days for that review, following which the

necessary amendments to the U.S. Tariff Schedule will be made by Presidential Proclamation. In Canada, the agreement will be implemented through Order-in-Council amendments to the Customs Tariff, following pre-publication in the Canada Gazetta to allow interested parties an opportunity to comment.

- In light of the approval processes in both countries, it is expected that the agreement will be implemented on July 1, 1991.
- The tariff acceleration process was established by the two governments in response to representations made by Canadian and U.S industries interested in faster tariff elimination. Interested parties were invited in February 1990 to submit specific requests. Nearly 500 applications were made to the Canadian and U.S. governments.
- on October 6, 1990, the consolidated list of requests received by the Canadian and U.S. governments was published in the <u>Canada Gazetta</u>. During the domestic consultation period that followed, more than 650 written submissions were received by the Government from industry associations, labour unions, and individual firms. The Government also solicited and received advice from its industry advisory groups, the International Trade Advisory Committee (ITAC) and the Sectoral Advisory Groups on International Trade (SAGITS), and from Provincial governments.
- On April 1, 1990, tariff reductions that resulted from the first round of accelerated tariff elimination consultations were implemented. The list of products included in the first round included more than 400 tariff items on each side covering approximately \$6 billion in two-way trade.
- In the Free Trade Agreement, Article 401.5 provides for accelerated elimination of tariffs subject to bilateral consultation.

The attached list identifies the tariff lines and products on which Canada and the United States have agreed to accelerate the elimination of the tariff, subject to the approval processes in both countries.

A 6-digit (subheading) number indicates that both countries have agreed to accelerated tariff elimination on all the 8-digit tariff items which fall under the subheading. However, where agreement has been reached to accelerate the tariff elimination only on specific products classified in a 6-digit subheading, these products have been listed. In cases where only one of the countries has decided to accelerate the elimination of the tariff, the country is named following the relevant 6-digit subheading or product.

In the majority of cases, the tariff will be eliminated effective July 1, 1991, or at the time of the implementation of this agreement. In cases where it was agreed to eliminate the tariff at a later date, the year is indicated in parentheses following the relevant 6-digit subheading or product.

For oilseeds and oilseed products, it should be noted that the tariff on the goods of 1204.00, 1205.00, 1507.10, 1508.10, 1508.90, 1509.10, 1509.90, 1510.00, 1512.11, 1512.19, 1512.21, 1512.29, 1514.10, 1514.90, 1515.90, 2304.00, 2306.20 and 2306.40 will be eliminated in two stages -- a 50 percent reduction in the FTA rate of duty on July 1, 1991, or at the time of the implementation of this agreement, and full elimination of the tariff on January 1, 1992. For the goods of 1507.90, the tariff phase-out schedule will remain as outlined in the Free Trade Agreement until July 1, 1994 when the FTA rate will be reduced by 50 percent, with full elimination on January 1, 1995. It should also be noted that the tariff on the hydrogenated oils of 1516.20 will be eliminated in the same timeframe as the refined oils classified in the subheadings listed above.
