
Sation of the Canadian Military Forces Overseas,

Rent Changes in Commands and Staffs.

- 1. This Report deals with those changes in commands and staffs which have occurred in the Canadian Army Overseas subsequent to 13 Jun 44 which was the date of Report No. 118. This period has witnessed several important changes, largely as a result of the participation of H.Q. First Cdn Army, 2 Cdn Corps and ancillary troops in the operations in Western Europe. A considerable number of commanders have become battle casualties.
- 2. The form of this Report is identical with that of Report No. 118. References in parentheses are to supplements to Canadian Army Overseas Routine Orders; dates are those on which the changes mentioned became effective. A list of officers commanding formations and holding first grade staff appointments, as at 23 Sep 44 is attached as Appendix "A".
- During the period covered by this Report a large number of changes have taken place in unit commands, a number of which have occurred as a result of battle casualties. It is not possible in this Report to list all these changes, but as an example two infantry brigades have been selected, and an account is given of the changes in command that have occurred in the three battalions of each brigade. This account will be found in paras 58-62.
- It might be noted as a matter of historical interest that Lieut.-General A.G.L. McNaughton, C.B., C.M.G., D.S.O., who brought 1 Cdn Div to England in December 1939 and subsequently became G.O.C.-in-C., First Cdn Army, has been promoted to the rank of General, and placed on the retired list. (Canadian Press News, LONDON, 7 Oct 44). Further information on General McNaughton's career will be found in Report No. 111, parss 4-7, and in Preliminary Narrative, The History of the Canadian Forces Overseas, 1939-1940, Chap. I, para 47.

HIGHER COMMANDS

- 5. There has been no change in the command at H.Q., Pirst Cdn Army, where Lieut.-General H.D.G. Crerar, C.B., D.S.O., remains as G.O.C.-in-C. The commands of the two Corps remain as at the date of the last Report.
- 6. Two important changes have occurred in divisional commands: A/Brigadier (now A/Major-General) D.C. Spry, D.S.O., who had been the commander of 12 Cdn Inf Bde since 13 Jul 44, was appointed to command 3 Cdn Div in succession to Major-General R.F.L. Keller, C.B.E. (4950, 18 Aug 44): Brigadier



H.W. Foster, formerly commanding 7 Cdn Inf Bde, became G.O.C. 4 Cdn Armd Div with the acting rank of Major-General, in succession to A/Major-General G. Kitching, D.S.O. (5010, 22 Aug 44) who has relinquished the acting rank of Major-General, and now commands 13 Cdn Inf Bde.

- 7. Major-General Keller, who was wounded on 8 Aug 44 by U.S. bombs dropped in the Canadian lines in error, has now returned to Canada. General Keller arrived in the United Kingdom as B.M. of 2 Cdn Inf Bde. On 20 Jul 40 he was appointed G.S.O.1, 1 Cdn Inf Div with the rank of Lt.-Col. In June 1941 he was appointed to command his old regiment, P.P.C.L.I., and in July 1941 assumed command of 1 Cdn Inf Bde. He received his last appointment, that of G.O.C., 3 Cdn Inf Div, on 8 Sep 42, and commanded the Division in the assault on Normandy (6 Jun 44) and thereafter until wounded.
- The new commander of 3 Cdn Inf Div, Major-General Spry, was born in Winnipeg on 4 Feb 13, and is thus at 31 the youngest Canadian General. Brigadier (then Major-General) Kitching had previously held that distinction (Report No. 118, para 18). The son of a General, the late Major-General D.W.B. Spry, General Spry began his military career as an N.P.A.M. officer. He was first commissioned with the P.L. Fus in 1932, shortly after receiving a P.F. appointment with the R.C.R. with whom he arrived overseas in 1939 as Capt. and Adjutant. His first important appointment was that of P.A. to the G.O.C.-in-C., which he held from 8 Sep 42 to 2 Aug 43. In August 1943 General Spry was appointed to command the R.C.R., whom he led during four months of operations in Sicily and Italy. His first brigade command was that of 1 Cdn Inf Bde which he held from 18 Dec 43 to 13 Jul 44. On the latter date he assumed the command of the newly formed 12 Can Inf Bde, where he remained until taking up his present appointment (see para 41).
- 9. During the period 9-17 Aug 44, prior to the arrival of General Spry from Italy, Brigadier K.G. Blackader, D.S.O., M.C., E.D., Commander of 8 Cdn Inf Bde, was temporarily in command of 3 Cdn Div (4950).
- Div, came overseas as B.M., 1 Cdn Inf Bde. Except for a short period as G.S.O. II (tempy) at H.Q., 1 Cdn Div, he held this appointment until 3 Jan 41. He was promoted Lt.-Col. and appointed to command 4 Cdn Recce Regt (4 P.L.D.G.) on 29 Jan 41. In August 1942 General Foster was appointed G.S.O. I, 1 Cdn Div, and in December 1942 assumed the command of the H.L.I. of C. In February 1943 he was promoted Brigadier and appointed to command 7 Cdn Inf Bde. General Foster went to Canada in the summer of 1943, and commanded 13 Cdn Inf Bde during the operations at KISKA in the Aleutian Islands. He returned overseas on 22 Jan 44 and resumed the command of 7 Cdn Inf Bde.

HEADQUARTERS, FIRST CANADIAN ARMY

11. Brigadier A.E. Walford, C.B.E., M.M., E.D. was promoted to the acting rank of Major-General (5103, 31 Aug 44) and vacated the appointment of D.A. & Q.M.G. He was succeeded by Brigadier J.F.A. Lister, O.B.E. (5103, 19 Sep 44) who had

been D.A. & Q.M.G. at H.Q., 1 Cdn Corps since 8 Apr 43.

- Major-General Walford has returned to Canada to assume the appointment of Adjutant-General at N.D.H.Q. General Walford, who during pre-war days commanded the 2nd Medium Brigade, R.C.A. (N.P.A.M.), was commissioned in the C.A.S.F. on 30 Oct 39, with the rank of Lt.-Col. He arrived overseas with H.Q., 1 Cdn Div as D.A.A.G., later holding the appointment of A.A. & Q.M.G. at the same H.Q. On 21 Dec 40 he was appointed A.A. & Q.M.G. at H.Q. Cdn Corps, remaining in that appointment until 6 Apr 42, when he was promoted Brigadier and appointed D.A. & Q.M.G. at H.Q., l Cdn Corps. In April 1943 he was appointed D.A. & Q.M.G. at H.Q., at H.Q., First Cdn Army.
- have been made in G.S.O. I appointments. Lt.-Col. (now A/Colonel) C.J. Laurin, O.B.E., has vacated the appointment of G.S.O. I (S.D. & T.) to become Colonel i/c Adm, Cdn Sec, G.H.Q., 1 Ech, 21 Army Gp. He has been succeeded by Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) P.S. Cooper (5143, 27 Sep 44). Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) W.B.G. Reynolds, succeeded Lt.-Col. C. Rankin, as G.S.O. I (Air) on 4 Sep 44 (5062). Two officers have held the C.A.C. appointment, Major F.T. Jenner, (4753, 12 Jun 44) and Lt.-Col. R.E.A. Morton, the present appointee (5062, 4 Sep 44). On 7 Sep 44, Lt.-Col. F.D. Lace, O.B.E., vacated the post of G.S.O. I (R.C.A.), to take command of 13 Cdn Fd Regt and was succeeded by Lt.-Col. F. le P.T. Clifford, previously commanding the same unit (5062, 7 Sep 44).
- In the M.S. Branch Lt.-Col. J.W. McClain has been appointed A.A.G. (4683, 2 Jun 44). The vacancy had been created by the appointment of Lt.-Col. A.G. Cherrier, to the post of A.A.G. (M.S.) at Cdn Sec, G.H.Q., 1 Ech (21 Army Group). Previous to Lt.-Col. McClain's appointment, from 10-28 May 44 Major G.H. Craig held the appointment (4610, 10 May 44).
- In the A.G. & Q.M.G. Branch, Lt.-Col. (now A/Colonel) F.B. Matthews succeeded Colonel J.R.R. Gough as Colonel A/Q (5103, 19 Sep 44). A/Lt.-Col. F.E.D. Wallace, O.B.E., E.D., Gen List, vacated the appointment of A.A.G. to become A.A. & Q.M.G. at H.Q., 1 Cdn L. of C. Terminal. He was succeeded by Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) H.M. Catheart, E.D., (4683, 7 Jun 44). Lt.-Col. G.S. Gibson, E.D., vacated the appointment of A.Q.M.G. (Movements), and was succeeded by Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) J.C. Clunie, (5080, 8 Sep 44).
- 16. In the office of the C.E., Brigadier G. Walsh, D.S.O., previously C.E. at H.Q., 2 Cdn Corps, has been appointed C.E. (5036, 2 Sep 44). Brigadier A.T. MacLean, C.B.E., M.C., V.D., whom he succeeded is at present at 1 N.E.T.D. awaiting return to Canada.
- 17. A/Colonel C.A. Campbell, O.B.E., vacated the appointment of D.C.E. (Works) and was succeeded by Lt.-Col. (now A/Brigadier) D.K. Black (4881, 27 Jul 44). Brigadier Black in turn vacated this appointment and was followed by Lt.-Col. (now A/Colonel) N.J.W. Smith (5036, 2 Sep 44).
- 18. At H.Q., Dep Comd, First Cdn Army, Brigadier R.O.G. Morton vacated the appointment of Dep Comd (4950, 13 Aug 44) to take command at H.Q. Army Tps Area (5036, 31 Aug 44).

On 18 Sep 44, Brigadier Morton vacated this appointment and is now at 1 N.E.T.D. awaiting return to Canada. He was succeeded by Colonel (now A/Brigadier) J.R.R. Gough (5103, 19 Sep 44) previously Colonel A/Q at H.Q., First Cdn Army. A/Brigadier W.G.H. Roaf, who, previous to Brigadier Morton's appointment, commanded at H.Q., Army Troops Area, was appointed to command at H.Q. 1 Cdn L. of C. Terminal (5036, 31 Aug 44). This vacancy was created by the appointment, subsequently mentioned, of A/Brigadier W.P. Gilbride, D.S.O., O.B.E. to the post of D.A. & Q.M.G. at H.Q., 1 Cdn Corps.

- 19. Brigadier A.E.D. Tremain, E.D. who vacated the command of Service Increment Gp H.Q., on 23 Aug 44 (4950), returned to Canada on 22 Sep 44 to return to civilian life.
- 20. In August 1944, all members of the Cdn Planning Staff vacated their appointments (4950).
- 21. There has been no change during this period in the command of either 1 or 2 Army Group, R.C.A.

HEADQUARTERS, 1ST CANADIAN CORPS

- At H.Q. 1 Cdn Corps, Brigadier J.D.B. Smith, O.B.E., previously commanding 5 Cdn Armd Bde, has been appointed to succeed Brigadier G.A. McCarter as B.G.S. (4704, 7 Jun 44). Lt.-Col. B.H. Darwin, vacated the appointment of G.S.O. I (Ops) to take that of A.Q.M.G. (Moves) (4851, 19 Jul 44). He was succeeded as G.S.O. I by Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) J.W. Eaton, previously B.M., 5 Cdn Armd Bde (4851, 19 Jul 44).
- 23. In the A.G. & Q.M.G. Branch Lt.-Col. (A/Brigadier) W.P. Gilbride, D.S.O., O.B.E., R.C.A.S.C., has been appointed D.A. & Q.M.G. succeeding Brigadier J.F.A. Lister, O.B.E., (5103, 19 Sep 44).
- 24. On the attached staff Brigadier A.B. Connelly, has vacated the appointment of C.E. (see para 53). He was succeeded by Lt.-Col. (now A/Brigadier) C.A. Campbell, O.B.E., previously D.C.E. (Works) at H.Q., First Cdn Army (4881, 27 Jul 44).

HEADQUARTERS, 2ND CANADIAN CORPS

- 25. The appointment of Brigadier Walsh to be C.E. at H.Q., First Cdn Army left this post vacant at H.Q., 2 Cdn Corps. The vacancy was filled by the promotion of Lt.-Col. (now A/Brigadier) D.K. Black (5036, 2 Sep 44). Brigadier Black as previously mentioned was D.C.E. (Works) at H.Q., First Cdn Army (see para 17).
- 26. Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) R.P. Rothschild, has succeeded Lt.-Col. R.W. Moncel as G.S.O. I (Ops) (5062, 19 Aug 44).

1ST CANADIAN DIVISION

At H.Q. 1 Cdn Div Lt.-Col. W.L. Coke was appointed A.D.M.S. (tempy) on 21 Aug 44 (5036) to succeed Colonel G.A. Sinclair. A/Lt.-Col. K.J. Southern, D.S.O. who was killed by a mine, was succeeded as C.R.E. by Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) E.H. Webb (4723, 28 May 44). Major Webb previously commanded 4 Cdn Fd Coy.

- 28. The transfer of Brigadier Spry to command 12 Cdn Inf Bde created a vacancy in the command of 1 Cdn Inf Bde which was filled by Lt.-Col. (now A/Brigadier) J.A. Calder, formerly commanding the Sask L.I. (4898, 13 Jul 44).
- 29. A/Brigadier J.P.E. Bernatchez, D.S.O., O.B.E., was wounded on 4 Sep 44 and vacated the command of 3 Cdn Inf Bde (5080, 4 Sep 44). Lt.-Col. M.P. Bogert, D.S.O. has been temporarily appointed to the command (5143, 5 Sep 44).

2ND CANADIAN DIVISION

- 30. At H.Q., 2 Cdn Div, Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) C.M. Drury, M.B.E., has succeeded Lt.-Col. C.R. Archibald as G.S.O. I (4935, 28 Jul 44).
- 31. Lt.-Col. (A/Colonel) S.G.U. Shier has been appointed A.D.M.S. (5080, 6 Sep 44) in succession to Colonel B.C. Leech, E.D. A/Colonel Shier formerly was A.D.M.S. at H.Q. Army Troops Area, First Cdn Army.
- Brigadier S. Lett, D.S.O., M.C., E.D., vacated the command of 4 Cdn Inf Bde and was succeeded by Lt.-Col. (now A/Brigadier) J.E. Ganong, E.D. (4950, 3 Aug 44). Brigadier Ganong in turn vacated (see para 56) and was followed by Lt.-Col. (now A/Brigadier) F.N. Cabeldu, D.S.O., E.D. from the command of 1 C Scot R (5143, 31 Aug 44). Brigadier Lett, who was wounded, has since returned to Canada. This officer has been twice wounded in this war; the first occasion was at Dieppe (cf. Report No. 87). At H.Q., 6 Cdn Inf Bde the command was left vacant by the promotion to A/Major-General of Brigadier H.A. Young, D.S.O. (5080, 31 Aug 44). For three days the command was held by A/Brigadier F.A. Clift, E.D., previously commanding the S. Sask R. (5036, 26 Aug 44). Brigadier Clift was wounded and vacated the command on 29 Aug 44. The command has been filled by the appointment of Lt.-Col. (now A/Brigadier) J.G. Gauvreau, formerly commanding Fus M.R. (5143, 30 Aug 44).
- 33. Major-General Young has had much experience as a staff officer overseas. His first important staff appointment was that of G.S.O. I (S.D.) at C.M.H.Q., to which he was appointed on 12 Oct 40. He left C.M.H.Q. on 6 Dec 41 to become G.S.O. I at 5 Cdn Armd Div, returning to C.M.H.Q. in June 1942 to be B.G.S., with the rank of Brigadier. On 7 Sep 42 General Young vacated this appointment to take command of 6 Cdn Inf Bde, which he has held ever since, except for a short period from 15 26 Feb 44 when he was B.G.S. at H.Q., 2 Cdn Corps. General Young has now returned to Canada where he will take over the appointment of Q.M.G. at N.D.H.Q.
- 34. The post of C.R.E. 2 Cdn Div, left vacant by the promotion to D.C.E. (Works) at H.Q., First Cdn Army, of Lt.-Col. N.J.W. Smith, has been filled by A/Lt.-Col. L.G.C. Lilley (5036, 2 Sep 44).

3RD CANADIAN DIVISION

35. There have been no changes in staff appointments at H.Q., 3 Cdn Div.

In June 1944 13 Cdn Inf Bde, which had participated in the joint U.S.-Canadian expedition to KISKA, arrived in the U.K. from Canada. The brigade came overseas under the command of Brigadier W.H.S. Macklin. Brigadier Macklin has since vacated the command to take up the appointment of D.C.G.S., C.M.H.Q. He was succeeded by Brigadier G. Kitching, D.S.O. (5036, 29 Aug 44), formerly G.O.C. 4 Cdn Armd Div.

CANADIAN MILITARY HEADQUARTERS

- 44. In the G.S. Branch at C.M.H.Q., Brigadier M.H.S. Penhale, C.B.E., formerly D.C.G.S., has returned to Canada to take up the appointment of D.C.G.S. (C) at N.D.H.Q. He was succeeded as D.C.G.S. by Brigadier W.H.S. Macklin (5010, 29 Aug 44), previously commanding 13 Cdn Inf Bde.
- In the Staff Duties Sub-Section Lt.-Col. E.G.
 Pullen relinquished the G.S.O. I appointment and was succeeded
 by A/Lt.-Col. C.A. Hamilton, M.B.E., E.D. (5143, 10 Sep 44).
 Lt.-Col. Pullen was promoted A/Colonel (5062, 31 Aug 44) and
 is now D.S.D. at N.D.H.Q. The appointment of Lt.-Col.
 Hamilton created a vacancy in the appointment of G.S.O. I,
 1 Increment, which was filled by Lt.-Col. F.S. Wilder
 (5080, 15 Sep 44). On 10 Oct 44 Lt.-Col. Wilder was appointed
 G.S.O. I (M.T.) succeeding Major (A/Lt.-Col.) D.D. Stewart,
 M.B.E. (5131). Lt.-Col. T.A. Johnston, E.D. has been
 succeeded as T.S.O. I (S.D.W.) by Lt.-Col. G.W. Ramsay (5143,
 12 Oct 44).
- 46. Several changes have occurred in the A.G. Branch. Lt.-Col. W.R. Wees succeeded Lt.-Col. J.W. Howard, E.D. as A.A.G. (SP) (4723, 11 Jun 44). Lt.-Col. E.H. Jones, D.C.M., E.D. has vacated as S.O. (Insp) on being promoted A/Colonel and seconded to the office of the High Commissioner for Canada (5010, 6 Sep 44). He was succeeded by Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) R.G. Rudolf, E.D. (5036, 6 Sep 44). Major C. Miller has been temporarily appointed A.A.G. (Pers) in succession to Lt.-Col. D.A. Clarke, C.B.E., M.C. (4881, 1 Aug 44).
- 47. The promotion of Colonel D.K. Tow, O.B.E., E.D., previously Colonel i/c Adm, Cdn Sec, G.H.Q. 1 Ech, (21 Army Gp), to the acting rank of Brigadier has been announced (5062, 8 Sep 44). Brigadier Tow has been appointed Director of Reorganization and Demobilization.
- 48. At the Overseas Canadian Records Office, Colonel R.T.E. Hicks-Lyne, M.C., has vacated as officer i/c and returned to Canada. He has been succeeded by Colonel A.M. Browne, O.B.E., V.D. (4683, 6 Jun 44). (See Report No. 118, para 71).
- 49. Brigadier C.A. Rae, E.D. who has held the appointment of Inspector of Hospitals since 9 Apr 44 has vacated the appointment. Brigadier Rae was S.O.S. the C.A.O. on 11 Sep 44 and returned to Canada for duty. It is understood that it is not intended to fill the vacancy thus created.

 Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) K.S. Ritchie, formerly D.A.D.M.S. I has succeeded Colonel G.G. Wood as A.D.M.S. I (4642, 22 May 44)

formerly A.D.Q.M.G. (Q), has succeeded Colonel E.B. Wilson, E.D. as A.D.Q.M.G. (4723, 12 Jun 44). Colonel Douglas was succeeded as A.D.Q.M.G. (Q) by Brigadier N.B. MacDonald, C.B.E. (4774, 21 Jun 44) formerly A.D.Q.M.G., Cdn Sec G.H.Q. 1 Ech (A.A.I.) (see para 56).

CANADIAN REINFORCEMENT UNITS

- A temporary change in organization took place in April 1944 at C.R.U. Space was required in the ALDERSHOT Area for formations and units being concentrated for the invasion of France. For this reason a number of the units under command of H.Q., C.R.U. were moved to new locations in Yorkshire. To meet the administrative problems raised by this change an increment to the H.Q. was formed, known as Adv H.Q., C.R.U. (C.M.H.Q. Adm 0. 77/44). Only one senior appointment was created by the formation of this H.Q.; that of Deputy Commander, C.R.U. Brigadier J.C. Stewart, C.B.E., D.S.O., previously commanding "C" Group, C.R.U. was the first to hold this command (4642, 19 Apr 44). He vacated on 5 Jul 44 and Brigadier J.R.S. Lough, D.S.O., M.C., V.D. was appointed Deputy Commander (tempy) (4774, 6 Jul 44). Brigadier Lough in turn vacated and was succeeded by Brigadier G.A. McCarter (4881, 51 Jul 44), who was the last to hold this appointment (see para 22). A report in the Press stated that Brigadier McCarter has now returned to Canada to take the command of an infantry brigade (Canada's Weekly, LONDON, 8 Sep 44).
- 52. At H.Q., C.R.U. Lt.-Col. J.E.C. Pangman, E.D., now commanding the Essex Scot vacated the G.S.O. I appointment on 25 Sep 44 and was succeeded by Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) J.C.H. Anderson, M.C. (5131, 7 Oct 44). Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) C.N. Bradshaw succeeded Lt.-Col. L.P.P. Payan, O.B.E., as A.A.G. (5062, 14 Sep 44). Lt.-Col. (now A/Colonel) W.J. Boyd, formerly D.A.D.M.S., has been appointed A.D.M.S., replacing Colonel J.F. Haszard, E.D. (4898, 4 Aug 44).
- At "B" Group, Brigadier A.B. Connelly, formerly C.E. at H.Q., 1 Cdn Corps, replaced Brigadier P.R. Shields, M.C., E.D. as Commander (5036, 8 Sep 44). Brigadier J.C. Stewart, upon vacating the command at Adv H.Q., C.R.U., resumed command at "G" Group (4774, 6 Jul 44). Colonel B.R. Ker, E.D., who had been temporarily in command of "G" Group (4642, 19 Apr 44), now commands at 1 C.G.R.U. (4774, 6 Jul 44). Brigadier J.R.S. Lough resumed the command of "D" Group on 31 Jul 44. "D" Group was commanded from 6 Jul 30 Jul 44 by Colonel A.S. Pearson, O.B.E., E.D., Commander of 3 C.I.R.U. (4774, 4881). Brigadier Lough vacated the appointment on 7 Sep 44 and was succeeded by A/Brigadier J.E. Ganong, E.D. (5036, 8 Sep 44) from the command of 4 Cdn Inf Bde. Brigadier Lough was repatriated to Canada on 22 Sep 44.
- 54. There have been no changes in commands at the H.Qs. of the two Base Reinforcement Groups in the theatres of war.

CANADIAN FORESTRY CORPS

55. At H.Q., C.F.C. Lt.-Col. (now A/Colonel) R.D. Roe, C.F.C. has been appointed to command (4842, 15 Jun 44).

Colonel C.E.F. Jones, C.P.C. whom Colonel Roe follows as Commander, now commands at H.Q., 1 Cdn Forestry Gp (4842, 15 Jun 44) which is at present operating in North West Europe under command G.H.Q & L of C Tps.

CANADIAN SECTION G.H.Q. 1ST ECHELON, A.A.I.

The promotion of A/Brigadier Gilbride to be D.A. & Q.M.G. at H.Q., 1 Cdn Corps, left vacant the appointment of Colonel i/c Adm. (see para 23). This vacancy has been filled by Colonel E.B. Wilson, O.B.E., E.D. (4808, 11 Jun 44) from A.D.Q.M.G. at C.M.H.Q. Brigadier N.B. MacDonald, C.B.E. vacated the appointment of A.D.Q.M.G. on 31 Jan 44 (4704 substituted for 4578). An appointment to fill this vacancy has not yet been announced.

57. Colonel D.K. Tow, O.B.E., E.D. has relinquished the appointment of Colonel i/c Adm (5062, 7 Sep 44) (see para 47). The appointment was temporarily held by Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) H.O. Moran, M.B.E. (5080, 17 Sep 44) from 17-26 Sep 44. He was replaced by Lt.-Col. (now A/Colonel) C.J. Laurin, O.B.E., formerly G.S.O. I (S.D. & T.), First Cdn Army (5131, 27 Sep 44). Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) N.S. Cuthbert has been appointed G.S.O. I (S.D. & T.) from G.S.O. II (5080, 1 Sep 44). In increment "A", Lt.-Col. J.G. McQueen has been appointed A.A. & Q.M.G. (5062, 29 Aug 44).

EXAMPLES OF RECENT CHANGES IN COMMANDS OF INFANTRY BATTALIONS

- In view of the heavy fighting in which the Canadian Army in France has been engaged since 6 Jun 44 and the consequent frequent changes in unit commands, a section on changes in unit commands has been included in this Report. As it is scarcely possible within the scope of this Report to show all the changes in unit commands in this period, two infantry brigades have been selected, and will be examined, as reflecting the typical situation. This Report, therefore, will be concerned with an examination of the changes in unit commands of 4 Cdn Inf Bde (2 Cdn Inf Div) and 9 Cdn Inf Bde (3 Cdn Inf Div).
- S9. The three battalions of 4 Cdn Inf Bde are the R.
 Regt C., R.H.L.I. and Essex Scot. In the R. Regt C. Lt.-Col.
 A.M. Young, now O.C. Adm Wing, 3 C.I.R.U., vacated on 21 Jul 44
 and was succeeded by Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) J.C.H. Anderson,
 M.C. (4881, 22 Jul 44). Lt.-Col. Anderson, who was wounded,
 was followed in the command by A/Lt.-Col. R.M. Lendrum from
 2 i/c 1 C. Scot R. (5062, 30 Aug 44). There have been three
 changes in the command of the R.H.L.I.; Lt.-Col. D.W. Whitaker
 was wounded on 19 Jul 44, and was succeeded by Lt.-Col.
 (now A/Brigadier) J.M. Rockingham, D.S.O. (4933, 17 Jul 44).
 Upon Brigadier Rockingham's promotion to command 9 Cdn Inf Bde,
 Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) G.M. MacLachlan assumed the command
 (4950, 5 Aug 44). He was wounded on 12 Aug 44, and was
 followed by Major (now A/Lt.-Col.) B.R. Ritchie (5062, 29 Aug 44)
 There have been four commanding officers of the Essex Scot
 since the landing in Normandy. The first of these was Lt.-Col.
 B.J.S. MacDonald, E.D., now specially employed (5131, 18 Aug 44).

Major (new A/Lt.-Cel.) T.S. Jones, who succeeded him, was wounded on 8 Aug 44 (4881, 23 Jul 44), and Major (new A/Lt.-Cel.) P.W. Bennett was appointed to the command (4950, 11 Aug 44) Lt.-Cel. Bennett was wounded on 21 Sep 44 and was succeeded by Lt.-Cel. J.E.C. Pangman (5131, 6 Sep 44).

- 60. Slightly fewer changes have occurred in the commands of the three battalions of 9 Cdn Inf Bde. In the case of the H.L.I. of C., Lt.-Col. F.M. Griffiths was wounded and was succeeded by Major (new A/Lt.-Col.) N. Kingsmill (4881, 20 Jul 44). Lt.-Col. C. Petch, commanding the Nth N.S. Highrs, has relinquished command and been succeeded by Major (new A/Lt.-Col.) D.F. Porbes, E.D. (4950, 5 Aug 44). Major (new A/Lt.-Col.) R. Rowley has replaced Lt.-Col. G.H. Christiansen, in the command of the S.D. & G. Highrs (4950, 5 Aug 44). Lt.-Col. Christiansen new commands the Adm Wing, 4 C.I.R.U.
- 61. Of the eleven changes in commands indicated above, it will be noted that six were the result of wounds and three for unspecified reasons; only two can be considered as resulting from promotions.
- 62. There is no doubt that meny changes of command (though not necessarily those just cited above) have been caused by the failure of the officers concerned to maintain the required standard of efficiency under battle conditions.
