

Deposits of \$10.00 or more are accepted against which orders may be placed. Orders are charged to the account and regular statements forwarded.

Cheques or money orders should be made payable to the Receiver General of Canada. Postage stamps are not acceptable.

No extra charge is made for postage on documents forwarded to points in Canada and the United States. To cover cost of postage, 30% is added to the selling price when publications are to be mailed to other countries.

All prices are subject to change without notice.

The Daily Checklist is the only medium for obtaining official publications free of charge from the Queen's Printer. The Daily Checklist is the form used by persons and institutions entitled to receive one free copy of each publication by authority of Treasury Board Regulation T.B. 477983 of March 31, 1955.
