Industrial monitor on CD-ROM

April 1997

Industrial monitor on CD-ROM offers data on 165 manufacturing industries and 33 non-manufacturing industries covering construction, wholesale and retail trade. This up-to-date information is offered on 24 sectors, and can be purchased by individual sector or as a complete package.

For each industry, up to 50 variables are organized in the "table viewer" in five table types, including supply, demand, price, labour/employment and investment/capital stock. The underlying database is also available via the "series browser" for more extensive time series analysis and inter-industry comparisons.

Industrial monitor on CD-ROM is linked to the *Standard industrial classification manual*, provides "pop-up" textual descriptions for every series and embodies consistent data conventions — all features designed to make analysis easy and accurate. State-of-the-art functions offer searching, graphing, viewing, exporting and transforming capabilities, providing you with the exact information you require quickly and easily.

The April 1997 issue of *Industrial monitor on CD-ROM* is now available. The full package (15F0015XCB) costs \$3,000, a savings of more than 40% over the annual subscription price of \$250 per individual sector. You will receive an updated CD-ROM once each month.

Construction type plywood

February 1997

Construction type plywood produced in February 1997 totalled 144 055 cubic metres, a decrease of 5.5% from the 152 482 cubic metres produced in February 1996.

Production in January and February 1997 totalled 293 560 cubic metres, a decrease of 5.3% from the 309 920 cubic metres produced during the same period in 1996.

Sawmills produced 5 141.3 thousand cubic metres of lumber and ties in January 1997, an increase of 3.3% from the 4 974.9 thousand cubic metres (revised) produced in January 1996.
