# Continuing decline in late fetal and perinatal mortality in Canada 1996

In 1996, 2,121 stillbirths of 20 weeks or more gestation were reported for residents of Canada (5.8 per 1,000 total births), compared with 2,353 in 1995 (6.2 per 1,000) and 2,321 in 1986 (6.2 per 1,000). For stillbirths of 28 weeks or more gestation (late fetal deaths), the rates per 1,000 total births were 3.4 in 1996, compared with 3.5 in 1995 and 4.2 in 1986.

The perinatal mortality rate, expressed here as the sum of late fetal deaths plus early neonatal deaths (under 1 week) per 1,000 total births was 6.7 in 1996, compared with 6.9 in 1995 and 8.4 in 1986. These figures show a continuation of the long-term trend of declining late fetal and perinatal mortality rates in Canada.

#### Cement

August 1998

Manufacturers shipped 1 273 811 tonnes of cement in August, up 3.9 % from 1 225 521 tonnes in August 1997, and up 3.7% from 1 228 929 tonnes in July 1998.

Year-to-date shipments totalled 7 555 629 tonnes, up 2.8% from 7 346 635 tonnes during the same period in 1997.


