Estimates of labour income

January 1998 (preliminary)

Labour income and employees' wages and salaries were virtually unchanged in January from the December 1997 level. Compared with one year earlier, labour income rose 3.2% to \$37.7 billion.

On a provincial and territorial basis, wages and salaries fell in January by 1.2% in Quebec, due in large part to temporary layoffs resulting from the ice storm. Newfoundland, New Brunswick, Alberta, the Yukon and the Northwest Territories also recorded declines. Increases in the remaining provinces, particularly Ontario, Manitoba and British Columbia, helped to offset these declines at the national level.

Wages and salaries paid to employees decreased in several of the industry groupings, whereas they rose markedly in "other utilities" (+7.3%). This was due to the increased overtime paid to electric power systems workers in Quebec and Ontario as they made repairs following the ice storm. In addition, wages and

salaries in transportation, storage and communications increased, partly a result of the end of the national strike at Canada Post.

Note: Labour income consists of wages and salaries (88%), plus supplementary labour income (12%). Wages and salaries include items such as bonuses, gratuities, taxable allowances and retroactive wage payments. Supplementary labour income is employers' contributions to employee welfare, pension, workers' compensation and employment insurance plans. Labour income accounts for about 52% of gross domestic product. Seasonally adjusted data are revised back to January 1997.


Steel primary forms

Week ending March 28, 1998 (preliminary)

Production of steel primary forms for the week ending March 28, 1998 totalled 280 498 metric tonnes, down 11.8% from the week-earlier 318 100 tonnes and down 2.3% from the year-earlier 287 021 tonnes. The year-to-date total at the end of the week was 3 814 629 tonnes,

a 10% increase compared with 3 468 134 tonnes for the same period in 1997.
